 VHS Positive Waters: The waters of Lakes Ontario, Erie and Huron (including Georgian Bay), flow connecting waterways and adjacent tributaries up to the first flood-prone barrier for all fish species. When fish are normally considered river salmon or pass through a barrier, the barrier will not be considered to be impassable. Local land-use/development for dams that do not normally stop salmon passage are not considered impassable. Waters associated with the Ontario Land Trust System waterways are considered to be VHS flow at the barrier line.

VHS Management Zone: The area bounded by the provincial road network, which encompasses the waters outlined as VHS positive waters in the above definition.

Lake Simcoe Management Zone: The area bounded by the provincial road network shown on the map.
