- xii. A board of health within the meaning of the *Health Protection and Promotion Act*.
- xiii. A community health centre within the meaning of Ontario Regulation 396/93 under the *Pay Equity Act*.
- xiv. A comprehensive health organization within the meaning of Ontario Regulation 396/93 under the *Pay Equity Act*.
- xv. A district health council established under the *Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care Act*.
- xvi. A facility owned by Canadian Blood Services.
- xvii. An independent health facility operated under the authority of a licence issued under the *Independent Health Facilities Act*.
- xviii. An organization that receives funding under the *Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care Act*.
- xvix. A place where emergency hostel services are provided under the *Ontario Works Act, 1997*.
- xx. A domiciliary hostel that receives funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act*.

- xxvii. A place where an emergency shelter service or homelessness prevention program that receives funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act* is provided.
- xxviii. A day nursery as defined in the *Day Nurseries Act*.
- xxix. A sheltered workshop that receives funding under the *Developmental Services Act* or the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act*.
- xxx. A place where a supported employment program that receives funding under the *Developmental Services Act* or the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act* is provided.
- xxxi. A place where an adults' community support service that receives funding under the *Developmental Services Act* is provided.
- xxxii. A place where an employment preparation, training and job placement program that receives funding under the *Developmental Services Act* is provided.
- xxxiii. A place where a violence against women program that receives funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act* is provided.
- xxxiv. A place where an aboriginal healing and wellness program that receives funding under the Aboriginal Healing and Wellness Strategy is provided.
- xxxv. An Ontario Early Years Centre or a satellite program of an Ontario Early Years Centre that receives funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act*.
- xxxvi. A district social services administration board established under the *District Social Services Administration Boards Act*.
- xxxvii. A place where an employment supports program that receives funding under the *Ontario Disability Support Program Act, 1997* is provided.

- xxxviii. A place where Rehabilitation Services for the Disabled that receive funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act* are provided.
- xxxix. A place where interpreter services programs or intervenor services programs that receive funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act* are provided.
- xl. A place where a discharge planning for ex-offenders program that receives funding under the *Ministry of Community and Social Services Act* is provided.
- 7. A consumer who annually uses at least 150,000 but not more than 250,000 kilowatt hours of electricity and who is not otherwise eligible for treatment as a designated consumer under the Act or a regulation made under the Act.
- 8. A consumer who has an account with a distributor if,
 - i. the consumer carries on a farming business within the meaning of the *Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993*,
 - ii. as of March 31, 2003, either the consumer held a valid registration number assigned under the *Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993* or the consumer's obligation to file a farming business registration form was waived pursuant to an order made under subsection 22 (6) of that Act, and
 - iii. the consumer is not otherwise eligible for treatment as a designated consumer under any provision of the Act or of a regulation made under the Act with respect to its farming business.

2. Clause 4.0.1 (1) (a) of the Regulation is amended by adding the following paragraph:

- 10. A mine as defined in the *Mining Act*;

3. (1) Subsection 4.0.2 (1) of the Regulation is amended by striking out the portion before clause (a) and substituting the following:

- (1) Clause 57 (b) of the Act and the other provisions of the Act listed in subsection (2) do not apply to a transmitter that transmits electricity for a price, if any, that is no greater than that required to recover all reasonable costs if,

(2) Clauses 4.0.2 (1) (a) and (b) of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:

- (a) the transmitter owns or operates a transmission system that is entirely or partially located on land on which one or more of the types of buildings or facilities described in subsection 4.0.1 (1) is also located;
- (b) the transmission system owned or operated by the transmitter was in existence on January 1, 2002 and, since that day has been used, if at all, for the sole purpose of permitting another person that holds a licence authorizing the other person to own or operate a transmission system to convey electricity from the IMO-controlled grid to consumers;

(3) Subclause 4.0.2 (1) (c) (ii) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

- (ii) the purpose described in clause (b), if the transmission system owned or operated by the transmitter was in existence on January 1, 2002 and, since that day, has been used, if at all, for the sole purpose described in clause (b).

(4) Subclause 4.0.2 (1) (d) (iii) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

- (iii) the purpose described in clause (b), if the transmission system owned or operated by the transmitter was in existence on January 1, 2002 and, since that day has been used, if at all, solely for the purposes described in clause (e); or

(5) Subclause 4.0.2 (1) (e) (iii) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

- (iii) the purpose described in clause (b), if the transmission system owned or operated by the transmitter was in existence on January 1, 2002 and, since that day, has been used, if at all, for the sole purpose described in clause (b).

(6) Section 4.0.2 of the Regulation is amended by adding the following subsection:

- (1.1) Clauses (1) (d) and (e) apply even if the transmitter that is a generator incidentally transmits electricity to a consumer that was connected on March 1, 2004 to the transmission system that the transmitter owns or operates.

COMMODITY PRICE FOR ELECTRICITY: LOW-VOLUME CONSUMERS AND DESIGNATED CONSUMERS

Conservation threshold

1. (1) The conservation threshold for low-volume consumers and designated consumers is 750 kilowatt hours per month.
- (2) Despite subsection (1), the conservation threshold for a low-volume consumer or designated consumer who has an account with a distributor,
 - (a) that relates to a property as defined in the *Condominium Act, 1998*, a residential complex as defined in the *Tenant Protection Act, 1997* or a property that includes one or more dwellings and that is owned or leased by a co-operative as defined in the *Co-operative Corporations Act*; and
 - (b) that relates to more than one unit in the property or complex,
 is 750 kilowatt hours per month multiplied by the number of units to which the account relates in the property or complex.
- (3) For the purpose of subsection (2), the number of units to which an account relates in a property or complex shall be deemed to be one unless a declaration attesting to the number of units and signed by the low-volume consumer or designated consumer is received,
 - (a) by the IMO, in the case of a low-volume consumer or designated consumer who is a market participant;
 - (b) by the retailer, in the case of retailer-consolidated billing; or
 - (c) by the distributor, in any other case.
- (4) The applicable conservation threshold for a billing period is determined with reference to the number of months in the billing period.

Commodity price for electricity

2. (1) For the purpose of 79.4 (1) (a) of the Act, the commodity price for electricity payable by a low-volume consumer or a designated consumer is,
 - (a) 4.7 cents per kilowatt hour for the electricity consumed during a billing period, up to and including the applicable conservation threshold; and
 - (b) 5.5 cents per kilowatt hour for the electricity consumed during a billing period in excess of the applicable conservation threshold.
- (2) The invoice from a distributor or, in the case of retailer-consolidated billing, a retailer to the low-volume consumer or designated consumer for each billing period must show as separate items the amount billed at 4.7 cents per kilowatt hour and the amount billed at 5.5 cents per kilowatt hour.

Transitional matters

3. (1) This section applies with respect to a billing period that includes the day on which this Regulation comes into force.
- (2) The distributor or, in the case of retailer-consolidated billing, the retailer may estimate the volume of electricity used by a low-volume consumer or designated consumer during the billing period that is to be allocated to the portion of the billing period that precedes that day and the volume to be allocated to the portion of the billing period that falls on and after it.
- (3) Despite section 2, the distributor or, in the case of retailer-consolidated billing, the retailer may calculate the amount payable for electricity used by a low-volume consumer or designated consumer during the billing period using an estimated charge for the entire billing period instead of the commodity price for electricity, if the estimated charge,
 - (a) is not less than 4.3 cents per kilowatt hour and not more than 4.7 cents per kilowatt hour in the case of a volume of electricity less than or equal to the applicable conservation threshold; and

- (b) is not less than 4.3 cents per kilowatt hour and not more than 5.5 cents per kilowatt hour in the case of a volume of electricity greater than the applicable conservation threshold.

Commencement

4. This Regulation comes into force on the later of the day that it is filed and the day that subsection 5 (1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Amendment Act (Electricity Pricing), 2003* is proclaimed in force.

- (a) the prices specified by Ontario Regulation 42/04 (Commodity Price for Electricity: Low-Volume and Designated Consumers) made under the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* that are payable by the consumer for electricity used on or after the day on which clause 79.4 (1) (a) of the Act comes into force and before May 1, 2005 or such earlier date as may be prescribed for the purposes of clause 79.4 (1) (a) of the Act, and
- (b) 4.3 cents per kilowatt hour for electricity used by the consumer on or after December 1, 2002 and before the day on which clause 79.4 (1) (a) of the Act comes into force;

(2) The definition of “contract price” in subsection 1 (2) of the Regulation is amended by striking out “section 79.4” and substituting “clause 79.4 (1) (a)”.

(3) Subsection 1 (2) of the Regulation is amended by adding the following definition:

“low-volume or designated consumer” means a low-volume consumer to whom subsection 79.4 (1) of the Act applies or a designated consumer to whom that subsection applies.

(4) The definition of “statutory price” in subsection 1 (2) of the Regulation is revoked.

2. Section 2 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

Application

 - (ii) holds an acceptable university degree or qualifications the College considers equivalent thereto, or technological qualifications, and
 - (iii) has successfully completed a program of professional education; and
- (b) the candidate has passed the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act*, unless the candidate is not required under that Act to pass the test before the certificate may be granted.

2. (1) Subsection 13 (1) of the Regulation is amended by striking out “and” at the end of clause (b), by adding “and” at the end of clause (c) and by adding the following clause:

- (d) the applicant has passed the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act*, unless the applicant is not required under that Act to pass that test before the certificate may be granted.

(2) Section 13 of the Regulation is amended by adding the following subsection:

(3) Despite subsections (1) and (2), the following rules apply if an interim certificate of qualification referred to in this section was granted after March 14, 2002 and before the day section 13.2 comes into force to an applicant who is required to pass the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act* but has not done so on or before the day section 13.2 comes into force:

- 1. The certificate shall be deemed, as of the day section 13.2 comes into force, to be an interim certificate of qualification (provisional) referred to in that section, valid for one year from the day the interim certificate of qualification was granted.
- 2. The interim certificate of qualification (provisional) referred to in paragraph 1 shall be deemed to have been granted on the day the interim certificate of qualification was granted.

3. (1) Subsection 13.1 (1) of the Regulation is amended by striking out “and” at the end of clause (b), by adding “and” at the end of clause (c) and by adding the following clause:

- (d) the applicant has passed the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act*, unless the applicant is not required under that Act to pass that test before the certificate may be granted.

(2) Subsection 13.1 (4) of the Regulation is amended by striking out “interim certificate of qualification (limited)” in the portion before clause (a) and substituting “interim certificate of qualification (limited) granted under subsection (1)”.

(3) Section 13.1 of the Regulation is amended by adding the following subsection:

(7) Despite subsections (1) to (6), the following rules apply if an interim certificate of qualification (limited) referred to in this section was granted after March 14, 2002 and before the day section 13.3 comes into force to an applicant who is required to pass the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act* but has not done so on or before the day section 13.3 comes into force:

1. The certificate shall be deemed, as of the day section 13.3 comes into force, to be an interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) referred to in that section, valid for one year from the day the interim certificate of qualification (limited) was granted.
2. The interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) referred to in paragraph 1 shall be deemed to have been granted on the day the interim certificate of qualification (limited) was granted.

4. The Regulation is amended by adding the following sections:

13.2 (1) The Registrar may grant an interim certificate of qualification (provisional), valid for one year, to an applicant who is required to pass the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act* but has not done so, if the Registrar is satisfied that the applicant has satisfied the requirements of clauses 13 (1) (a) to (c).

(2) An interim certificate of qualification referred to in section 13 may be granted to the holder of an interim certificate of qualification (provisional) referred to in subsection (1) if the holder passes the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act*,

- (a) within the one-year period after the date the interim certificate of qualification (provisional) was granted; or
- (b) within the one-year period referred to in subsection 13 (3), in the case of a certificate that is deemed under that subsection to be an interim certificate of qualification (provisional).

(3) An interim certificate of qualification referred to in subsection (2) is valid for a period of six years from the date that the interim certificate of qualification (provisional) referred to in that subsection was granted or is deemed to have been granted.

13.3 (1) The Registrar may grant an interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional), valid for one year to an applicant who is required to pass the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act* but has not done so, if the Registrar is satisfied that the applicant has satisfied the requirements of clauses 13.1 (1) (a) to (c).

(2) An interim certificate of qualification (limited) referred to in section 13.1 may be granted to the holder of an interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) referred to in subsection (1) if the holder passes the qualifying test under section 10.1 of the *Education Act*,

- (a) within the one-year period after the date the interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) was granted; or
- (b) within the one-year period referred to in subsection 13.1 (7), in the case of a certificate that is deemed under that subsection to be an interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional).

(3) An interim certificate of qualification (limited) referred to in subsection (2) is valid for three years from the date the interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) referred to in that subsection was granted or is deemed to have been granted.

(4) The Registrar may impose any conditions on an interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) that the Registrar may impose on an interim certificate of qualification (limited) under subsection (2) of section 13.1.

18.1 If an interim certificate of qualification (provisional) referred to in subsection 13 (3) or section 13.2 or an interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional) referred to in subsection 13.1 (7) or section 13.3 expires without the holder qualifying for an interim certificate of qualification or an interim certificate of qualification (limited), the holder of the certificate is not eligible for another interim certificate of qualification (provisional) or interim certificate of qualification (limited, provisional).
