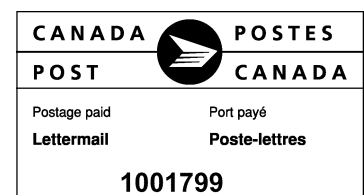

NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION

Commitment to the Future of Medicare Act, 2004 Part I - Ontario Health Quality Council

The Minister of Health and Long-Term Care on behalf of the Government of Ontario invites public comments on a regulation proposed to be made under the Commitment to the Future of Medicare Act, 2004.

The Commitment to the Future of Medicare Act, 2004 was passed by the Legislature on June 7, 2004 and received Royal Assent on June 17, 2004. Section 7 of Part I (Public consultation before making regulations) came into force upon Royal Assent. The remaining sections of Part I (ss. 1-6) will come into force at a later date. Part I of the Act relates to the Ontario Health Quality Council. Before Part I of the Act comes into force in its entirety, the Government is considering the development of a regulation to establish and support the operationalization of the Council. Section 7 of the Act requires that the Minister publish a notice of the proposed regulation and allow 60 days for public comment, after which the Minister reports to the Lieutenant Governor in Council, who may then finalize the regulation with or without changes.

Proposed Regulation under the *Commitment to the Future of Medicare Act, 2004*

The regulation proposed to be made under the Commitment to the Future of Medicare Act, 2004 includes the following:

- Establishes the Ontario Health Quality Council as a corporation without share capital, with a board of directors consisting of the members of the Council appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council: subsections 1(1) and (2).
- A member's appointment is for three years, with the possibility of reappointment for one further term: subsection 1(3).
- The initial appointments of members will be for terms of two and three years, one-half being for two and one-half being for three years. This will result in rotating terms with half of the members being changed every three years. This ensures continuity in the renewal process: subsection 1(4).
- The person appointed to the Ontario Health Quality Council who is also appointed to the Health Council of Canada will hold office on the Ontario Council for the same term as on the national council: subsection 1(5).
- To ensure the rotating terms, where a person ceases to be a Council Member, the person appointed to succeed that person can only be appointed for the remainder of the first person's term: subsection 1(6).
- The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall choose the Chair and vice-Chair, and the role of the Chair is defined: subsections 1(7) and (8).
- Members of the Council are entitled to be paid remuneration as fixed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and are also entitled to be paid reasonable expenses: subsection 1(9).
- The Council must meet regularly, and a minimum of four times each year: subsection 1(10).
- Quorum is a majority of members of the Council: subsection 1(11).
- The Council is an agent of Her Majesty: section 2.
- The Corporations Act and the Corporations Information Act do not apply to the Council. The sections of the Business Corporations Act that deal with the standard of care of directors, the conflict of interest provisions and the ability of the corporation to indemnify the members apply to the Council: section 3.
- The Council has all the powers of a natural person in order to carry out its functions. There are also restrictions on these powers: the Council cannot acquire, hold or dispose of any interest in real property, borrow money or pledge its assets, or create a subsidiary without the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council: section 5.
- The members of the Council have the power, subject to the approval of the Minister, to pass by-laws and resolutions in order to conduct and manage its affairs and, in particular, the ability to appoint officers, make banking arrangements and establish committees: section 6.
- The Council has to hire a chief executive officer, who is responsible for the operation of the Council, subject to the supervision and direction of the Council. The CEO may hire employees as are necessary. The CEO and employees are not members of the Ontario Public Service: section 7.
- The Council may only collect de-identified personal health information. The definition of de-identified information is the same as in the Health Information Protection Act, 2004. The Council can only commission the creation of information from sources approved by the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care: section 8.
- The Council cannot sell any analysis of the information it has collected without the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council: section 9.
- The Council's fiscal year is the same as the Ontario government's April 1 to March 31: section 10.
- The Council has to appoint auditors, and give a copy of the auditors' report to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care: section 11.
- The Council has to give an annual report on its affairs to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care, which report is to be laid before the Legislative Assembly: section 12.
- The Council's yearly report on the health system may report respecting access to health care services, availability of health human resources, health and wellness of the population, and the quality, efficiency and effectiveness of health care services: section 13.
- The Minister may wind up the affairs of the Council, if it is in the public interest to do so, by liquidating or selling the assets of the Council and paying them into the Consolidated Revenue Fund or by transferring them to the Crown or an agency of the Crown: section 14.

Invitation to Provide Comments on the Proposed Regulation

The public is invited to provide written comments on the draft regulation over a 60 day period, commencing on September 25, 2004 and ending on November 24, 2004.

In providing comments, please consider whether the proposed provisions should be included in the final regulation, with or without changes. Furthermore, please consider whether any other provisions should be included in the regulation. Please be as specific as possible, and provide a full rationale for any suggested changes or additions.

ONTARIO REGULATION

made under the

COMMITMENT TO THE FUTURE OF MEDICARE ACT, 2004

ONTARIO HEALTH QUALITY COUNCIL

Council established

1. (1) A corporation without share capital is established, under the name "Ontario Health Quality Council" in English, and "Conseil ontarien de la qualite des services de sante" in French.

(2) The Council consists of the members of the Council appointed by the Lieutenant Governor under subsection 2 (2) of the Act, who shall serve as the board of directors of the corporation established under subsection (1).

(3) Subject to subsections (4), (5) and (6), members of the Council hold office for a term of three years and may be re-appointed for one further term.

(4) Of the initial appointments of the members of the Council, as nearly as possible,

- (a) one-half shall be appointed for a term of two years; and
- (b) one-half shall be appointed for a term of three years.

(5) The person appointed under subsection 2 (6) of the Act shall hold office for the duration of the term of his or her appointment on a similar council for Canada and the provinces and territories of Canada.

(6) If a person ceases to be a member of the Council, the first term of appointment of the person appointed to succeed that person may only be for the remainder of the first person's term.

(7) One of the members shall be the Chair of the Council, and one of the members shall be the vice-Chair, as provided for by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

(8) The Chair shall preside at all meetings of the Council and, in the absence of the Chair or if the office is vacant, the vice-Chair shall have all the powers and shall perform the duties of the Chair.

(9) Members of the Council who are not members of the public service of Ontario are entitled to be paid such remuneration as is fixed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and are entitled to be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in performing their duties under the Act and this Regulation.

(10) The Council shall meet regularly throughout the year at the call of the Chair, and, in any event, at least four times a year.

(11) A majority of members of the Council constitutes a quorum for meetings of the Council.

Crown agent

2. The Council is for all its purposes an agent of Her Majesty, its powers may be exercised only as an agent of Her Majesty, and all property acquired by the Council is the property of Her Majesty.

Non-application of Acts

3. The Corporations Act and the Corporations Information Act do not apply to the Council.

Conflict of interest, indemnities and standard of care

4. Section 132, subsection 134 (1) and section 136 of the Business Corporations Act apply to the Council and to its members with necessary modifications.

Powers of Council

5. (1) The Council has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for carrying out its functions, except as limited by the Act or this Regulation.

(2) The revenues of the Council, including all money or assets received by the Council by grant, gift, contribution, profit or otherwise, shall only be used to further its functions.

(3) The Council shall not, except with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council,

- (a) acquire, hold or dispose of any interest in real property;
- (b) borrow money;
- (c) pledge the assets of the Council; or
- (d) create any subsidiary.

Powers of members

6. (1) The affairs of the Council are under the management and control of its board of directors.

(2) The Council may, subject to the approval of the Minister, pass by-laws and resolutions for conducting and managing its affairs, including,

- (a) appointing officers and assigning to them such powers and duties as the board considers appropriate;
- (b) maintaining bank accounts and making other banking arrangements; and
- (c) establishing committees

Chief executive officer and employees

7. (1) The Council shall appoint a chief executive officer.

(2) The chief executive officer is responsible for the operation of the Council, subject to the supervision and direction of the Council.

(3) The chief executive officer may appoint such employees as are considered necessary for the proper conduct of the affairs of the Council.

(4) The employees are not civil servants, public servants or Crown employees within the meaning of the Public Service Act.

Collection of information

8. (1) The Council may only collect de-identified personal health information for the purposes of carrying out its functions and making its reports.

(2) The Council shall not commission the creation of information by sources that are not approved by the Minister.

(3) In subsection (1),

“de-identified personal health information” means personal health information of an individual that has had removed from it any information that identifies the individual or any information for which it is reasonably foreseeable in the circumstances that it could be utilized, either alone or with other information to identify the individual.

Restriction on sale

9. The Council shall not sell any analysis of the information it has collected, or any of its services, without the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

Fiscal year

10. The Council's fiscal year begins on April 1 in each year and ends on March 31 in the following year.

Auditor

11. (1) The Council shall appoint one or more auditors licensed under the Public Accountancy Act to audit annually the accounts and financial transactions of the corporation.

(2) The Council shall give a copy of every auditor's report to the Minister within six months after the end of the fiscal year to which the report relates, and shall make available to the Provincial Auditor, on his or her request, the auditor's report and all accounts, records and other documents relating to the audit.

(3) The Minister may require that any aspect of the affairs of the Council be audited by an auditor appointed by the Minister.

Report on affairs

12. (1) Within six months of the end of each fiscal year of the Council, the Council shall give the Minister a report on its affairs for the preceding fiscal year.

(2) The report mentioned in subsection (1) must include any information specified by the Minister.

(3) The Minister shall submit the report mentioned in subsection (1) to the Lieutenant Governor in Council and shall then table it in the Legislative Assembly.

(4) The Council shall give the Minister such other information and reports on its affairs and operations as the Minister may require.

Yearly report

13. In its yearly report under section 5 of the Act, the Council may report respecting,

- (a) access to health care services, including primary health care and community based health services;
- (b) availability of health human resources, including physicians, nurses and other health care professionals;
- (c) health and wellness of the population; and

- (d) quality, efficiency and effectiveness of health care services.

Winding-up

14. If the Minister considers it to be in the public interest to wind up the affairs of the Council, he or she may do all things necessary to accomplish that, including dealing with the assets of the Council by,

- (a) liquidating or selling the assets and paying the proceeds into the Consolidated Revenue Fund; or
- (b) transferring the assets to the Crown, including another agency of the Crown.

Le ministre de la Santé et des Soins de longue durée invite, au nom du gouvernement de l'Ontario, le public à présenter des commentaires sur le projet de règlement pris en application de la Loi de 2004 sur l'engagement d'assurer l'avenir de l'assurance-santé.

La Loi de 2004 sur l'engagement d'assurer l'avenir de l'assurance-santé a été adoptée par l'Assemblée législative le 7 juin 2004 et a reçu la sanction royale le 17 juin 2004. Avant que la Partie I de la Loi n'entre en vigueur dans son intégralité, le gouvernement étudie la possibilité d'élaborer un règlement qui permettra d'établir et d'assurer l'opérationnalisation du Conseil. L'article 7 de la Loi oblige le ministre à publier un avis du projet de règlement et à prévoir un délai de 60 jours pour les commentaires du public, après quoi le ministre donne rapport au lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil, qui peut alors sanctionner le règlement avec ou sans modifications.

Projet de règlement pris en application de la Loi de 2004 sur l'engagement d'assurer l'avenir de l'assurance-santé

Le projet de règlement d'application de la Loi de 2004 sur l'engagement d'assurer l'avenir de l'assurance-santé comprend les dispositions suivantes :

- Le Conseil ontarien de la qualité des services de santé sera établi à titre de personne morale sans capital-actions doté d'un conseil d'administration composé des membres du Conseil nommés par le lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil : paragraphes 1(1) et (2).
- Les membres seront nommés pour une période de trois ans, avec la possibilité d'obtenir un nouveau mandat une seule fois: paragraphe 1(3).
- Pour le mandat initial, les membres seront nommés pour une durée de deux ou trois ans, la moitié des membres étant nommés pour deux ans et l'autre moitié pour trois ans. Cette méthode permettra d'obtenir une rotation des mandats où la moitié des membres change tous les trois ans, ce qui assurera une continuité dans le processus de renouvellement : paragraphe 1(4).

- Le lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil choisira le président et le vice-président du Conseil, et le rôle du président est défini : paragraphes 1(7) et (8).
- Les membres du Conseil recevront une rémunération que déterminera le lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil et seront

également admissibles à un remboursement des dépenses raisonnables : paragraphe 1(9).

- Le Conseil se réunira régulièrement, au moins quatre fois l'an : paragraphe 1(10).
- Le quorum sera constitué de la majorité des membres du Conseil : paragraphe 1(11).
- Le Conseil sera un agent de Sa Majesté: article 2.
- La Loi sur les personnes morales et la Loi sur les renseignements exigés des personnes morales ne s'appliqueront pas au Conseil. Les articles de la Loi sur les sociétés par actions qui concernent les devoirs des administrateurs, les dispositions relatives au conflit d'intérêt et la capacité de la société d'indemniser les membres s'appliqueront au Conseil : articles 3 et 4.
- Le Conseil sera investi des pouvoirs d'une personne physique dans l'exercice de ses fonctions. - Le Conseil sera habilité, sous réserve de l'approbation du ministre, à adopter des règlements administratifs et des résolutions qui lui permettront de gérer ses affaires et, en particulier, il sera habilité à nommer des agents, conclure des conventions bancaires et établir des comités : article 6.
- Le Conseil engagera un chef de direction, qui sera responsable des activités du Conseil, sous la supervision et la direction du Conseil. Le chef de direction pourra embaucher des employés au besoin. Le chef de direction et les employés ne sont pas des employés de la fonction publique de l'Ontario : article 7.
- Le Conseil ne pourra recueillir que des renseignements personnels anonymisés sur la santé. La définition des renseignements anonymisés sera la même que celle de la Loi de 2004 sur la protection des renseignements personnels sur la santé. Le Conseil ne pourra commander la compilation de renseignements qu'à des sources approuvées par le ministre de la Santé et des Soins de longue durée : article 8.
- Le Conseil ne pourra vendre aucune analyse des renseignements recueillis sans l'approbation du lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil : article 9.
- L'exercice financier du Conseil sera le même que celui du gouvernement de l'Ontario, il s'étendra du 1er avril au 31 mars : article 10.
- Le Conseil nommera des vérificateurs et soumettra une copie du rapport des vérificateurs au ministre de la Santé et des Soins de longue durée : article 11.
- Le Conseil soumettra un rapport annuel de ses activités au ministre de la Santé et des Soins de longue durée, lequel sera présenté à l'Assemblée législative : article 12.
- Le rapport annuel du Conseil sur le système de santé peut traiter de l'accès aux services de santé, de la disponibilité de ressources humaines dans le secteur de la santé, de la santé et du bien-être de la population, et de la qualité, de l'efficacité et de l'efficacité des services de santé : article 13.
- Le ministre pourra liquider les affaires du Conseil, si c'est dans l'intérêt public d'agir de la sorte, en liquidant ou en vendant les actifs du Conseil et en versant le produit dans le Trésor ou en les transférant à la Couronne ou à un organisme de la Couronne : article 14.

1. (1) Est créée une personne morale sans capital-actions appelée Conseil ontarien de la qualité des services de santé en français et Ontario Health Quality Council en anglais.

(2) Le Conseil se compose des membres qu'y nomme le lieutenant-gouverneur en application du paragraphe 2 (2) de la Loi, lesquels forment le conseil d'administration de la personne morale créée par le paragraphe (1).

«renseignements personnels sur la santé anonymisés» Renseignements personnels sur la santé dont ont été retranchés les éléments qui identifient le particulier qu'ils concernent ou ceux dont il est raisonnable de prévoir, dans les circonstances, qu'ils puissent être utilisés, seuls ou avec d'autres, pour l'identifier.

Vente sous condition

9. Le Conseil ne doit pas vendre l'analyse des renseignements qu'il a recueillis ni ses services sans l'approbation du lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil.

Exercice

10. L'exercice du Conseil commence le 1er avril et se termine le 31 mars de l'année suivante.

Vérificateurs

11. (1) Le Conseil nomme un ou plusieurs vérificateurs titulaires d'un permis délivré en vertu de la Loi sur la comptabilité publique qu'il charge de vérifier chaque année les comptes et les opérations financières de la personne morale.

(2) Le Conseil remet au ministre une copie de chaque rapport du vérificateur dans les six mois qui suivent la fin de l'exercice visé par le rapport et met à la disposition du vérificateur provincial, à la demande de celui-ci, le rapport du vérificateur ainsi que tous les comptes, dossiers et autres documents qui se rapportent à la vérification.

(3) Le ministre peut exiger que tout aspect des affaires du Conseil soit vérifié par un vérificateur que nomme le ministre.

Rapport

12. (1) Le Conseil remet au ministre un rapport sur ses affaires de l'exercice précédent dans les six mois qui en suivent la fin.

(2) Le rapport mentionné au paragraphe (1) comprend les renseignements que précise le ministre.

(3) Le ministre présente le rapport mentionné au paragraphe (1) au lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil et le dépose ensuite devant l'Assemblée législative.

(4) Le Conseil remet au ministre les autres renseignements et rapports sur ses affaires et activités qu'exige celui-ci.

Rapport annuel

1. Regulation 1012 of the Revised Regulations of Ontario, 1990 is amended by adding the following sections:

1.1 (1) For the purposes of clause (c.1) of the definition of “taxable service” in subsection 1 (1) of the Act,

“to configure a computer program” means to perform work required to input customer-specific values and parameters into a computer program or hardware;

“to install a computer program” means to perform work required to load a computer program onto hardware in order to permit the user to set up or operate the computer program;

“to modify a computer program” means to change the source code of a computer program;

“to upgrade a computer program” means to remedy problems within a computer program or between computer programs, or provide an improvement to the computer program that is offered to or available to all licensees of that computer program.

(2) For the purposes of clause (d.1) of the definition of “taxable service” in subsection 1 (1) of the Act,

“service or maintenance of a computer program” means the installation, configuration, modification or upgrading of a computer program;

“warranty of a computer program” means an undertaking that the computer program will function as required by the purchaser or as guaranteed by the producer or vendor.

(3) Despite subsections (1) and (2), non-taxable services include,

(a) training with respect to the use of a computer program;

(b) advising users of a computer program;

(c) performing activities relating to the management of data;

(d) project planning, including the analysis of specifications, determination and verification of hardware and software prerequisites, scheduling, the preparation of reports, review of documentation and discussions of any kind; and

(e) testing a computer program, unless the testing is done in connection with a taxable service described in subsection (1) and the value of the taxable service exceeds 10 per cent of the value of the testing.

(4) For the purposes of clause (3) (e),

“value” means, with respect to a taxable service or testing,

(a) the cost of the taxable service or testing,

(b) the fair value of the taxable service or testing,

(c) the value of the time spent by or on behalf of the vendor to provide the taxable service or the testing; or

(d) the value as determined by any other reasonable method.

1.2 (1) If taxable and non-taxable services relating to a computer program are sold together on or after July 19, 2002 for one price, the fair value of the services sold to the purchaser is determined in accordance with this section for the purposes of subsection 2 (9) of the Act.

(2) Subject to subsections (3), (4) and (5), the fair value of the services sold to the purchaser is the price paid by the purchaser for all of the services.

(3) If all of the following circumstances exist, the fair value of the services sold to the purchaser is any separate and reasonable charge specified by the vendor for the taxable services:

1. The vendor specifies separate and reasonable charges for the taxable and the non-taxable services.
2. The separate charges are clearly communicated to the purchaser.
3. The vendor maintains a record of the separate charges for the taxable services.

(4) If any of the following circumstances exist, the fair value of the services sold to the purchaser is zero:

1. The cost, to the vendor, of the taxable services sold to the purchaser is a maximum of 10 per cent of the cost, to the vendor, of the non-taxable services sold to the purchaser.
2. The fair value of the taxable services sold to the purchaser is a maximum of 10 per cent of the fair value of the non-taxable services, if each of them were to be sold separately to the purchaser.
3. The time spent by or on behalf of the vendor to provide the taxable services sold to the purchaser is a maximum of 10 per cent of the time spent by or on behalf of the vendor to provide the non-taxable services sold to the purchaser.
4. On the basis of any other reasonable determination, the taxable services component of a contract is a maximum of 10 per cent of the non-taxable services component of the contract.

(5) Subsection (4) applies to a contract entered into before September 14, 2004 for the sale of taxable and non-taxable services even if the contract specifies separate charges for the taxable and non-taxable services.

1.3 (1) If one or more computer programs are sold together with taxable and non-taxable services relating to computer programs on or after July 19, 2002 for one price, the fair value of the combined computer programs and services sold to the purchaser is determined in accordance with this section for the purposes of subsection 2 (9) of the Act.

(2) Subject to subsections (3), (4) and (5), the fair value of the combined computer programs and services sold to the purchaser is the price paid by the purchaser for all of the components.

(3) If all of the following circumstances exist, the fair value of the combined computer programs and services sold to the purchaser is any separate and reasonable charge specified by the vendor for the taxable computer programs and taxable services related to computer programs:

1. The vendor specifies separate and reasonable charges for the exempt and taxable computer programs and for the taxable and the non-taxable services.
2. The separate charges are clearly communicated to the purchaser.
3. The vendor maintains a record of the separate charges for the taxable computer programs and taxable services.

(4) If any of the following circumstances exist, the fair value of the combined computer programs and services sold to the purchaser is zero:

1. The cost, to the vendor, of the taxable computer programs and taxable services sold to the purchaser is a maximum of 10 per cent of the cost, to the vendor, of the exempt computer programs and non-taxable services sold to the purchaser.
2. The fair value of the taxable computer programs and taxable services sold to the purchaser is a maximum of 10 per cent of the fair value of the exempt computer programs and non-taxable services, if each of them were to be sold separately to the purchaser.
3. The time spent by or on behalf of the vendor to provide the taxable computer programs and taxable services sold to the purchaser is a maximum of 10 per cent of the time spent by or on behalf of the vendor to provide the exempt computer programs and non-taxable services sold to the purchaser.
4. On the basis of any other reasonable determination, the taxable computer programs and taxable services components of a contract are a maximum of 10 per cent of the exempt computer programs and non-taxable services components of the contract.

(5) Subsection (4) applies to a contract entered into before September 14, 2004 for the sale of combined computer programs and services even if the contract specifies separate charges for the exempt and taxable computer programs and for the taxable and non-taxable services.

2. (1) The definition of “modifications” in subsection 14.2 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

“modifications” means changes other than upgrades made to the source code of a computer program;

(2) Subsection 14.2 (1) of the Regulation is amended by adding the following definition:

“upgrades” means improvements to a computer program that are offered to or available to all licensees of that computer program.

(3) Clause 14.2 (2) (c) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

- (c) a modification is made before July 19, 2002 to a pre-written computer program solely to meet the specific requirements of a particular person and the price of, or payment for, the modification is separate from and is greater than the price of, or payment for, the computer program;
- (c.1) one or more modifications are made to a pre-written computer program to meet the specific requirements of a particular person and the price of, or payment for, all such modifications made on or after July 19, 2002 is separate from and is greater than the price of, the payment for or the cost of the computer program;
- (c.2) one or more modifications are made to a pre-written computer program by a particular person and the salary cost of making all such modifications made on or after July 19, 2002 is separate from and is greater than the price of, the payment for or the cost of the computer program;
- (c.3) a combination of the modifications described in clauses (c.1) and (c.2) are made to a pre-written computer program and the price of, the payment for or the salary cost of all such modifications made on or after July 19, 2002 is separate from and is greater than the price of, the payment for or the cost of the computer program;
