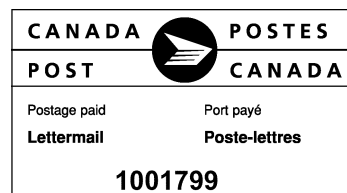

- (b) in the case of an application, matter or proceeding appealed or referred to the Ontario Municipal Board from the council's neglect, refusal or failure to make a decision relating to an official plan or official plan amendment, on the day that the Ontario Municipal Board makes a decision disposing of the application, matter or proceeding.

**REFRIGERATION AND AIR CONDITIONING MECHANIC****Definition**

**1.** In this Regulation,

“certified trade” means the trade of refrigeration and air conditioning mechanic.

**Designation as certified trade**

**2.** The trade of refrigeration and air conditioning mechanic is designated as a certified trade for the purposes of the Act and shall consist of the following two branches:

- 1. Refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic.
- 2. Residential air conditioning systems mechanic.

**Scope of trade**

**3. (1)** The performance of any of the following functions constitutes work that is part of the certified trade:

- 1. Plan, prepare and lay out the system.
- 2. Install and start up the system and verify the operation and function of the system.

3. Install and connect piping for the purpose of conveying all types of refrigerant used for both primary and secondary cooling.
4. Maintain, service, repair and replace system components and accessories, including the electrical and electronic components of the system.
5. Service, test, adjust, commission and decommission the system.

(2) A person who holds a certificate of qualification as a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic, and any other person authorized under the Act to work as a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic, may perform the functions described in subsection (1) with respect to any cooling system or heating-cooling combination system that is installed and used in a residential, industrial, commercial or institutional setting.

(3) A person who holds a certificate of qualification as a residential air conditioning systems mechanic, and any other person authorized under the Act to work as a residential air conditioning systems mechanic, may perform the functions described in subsection (1) only with respect to residential air conditioning systems that meet the following requirements:

1. The system shall be installed as an independent unit in a residential family dwelling.
2. The system shall operate at no more than 240 volts single-phase power with a maximum branch circuit capacity of 60 amps, a maximum cooling capacity of 60,000 British thermal units per hour and a saturated suction temperature above 2 degrees Celsius (35 degrees Fahrenheit) in the cooling cycle.

(4) For greater certainty, the performance of the following work does not constitute work that is part of the certified trade:

1. Work performed by a person engaged in the repair or installation of single-phase hermetically sealed self-contained portable plug-in appliances with a maximum voltage of 240 volts and with factory produced systems pre-charged with refrigerant.
2. Work performed by a person engaged in the production of refrigeration and air conditioning systems.

(5) Nothing in this section authorizes a person who holds a certificate of qualification or is otherwise authorized under the Act to work in the certified trade to perform any function or carry out any activities for which a certificate is required under the *Technical Standards and Safety Act, 2000*.

#### **Training programs**

4. (1) An apprentice training program to become a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic shall consist of five periods, each of which shall consist of 1800 hours of classes that provide training and instruction and of on the job work experience.

(2) An apprentice training program to become a residential air conditioning systems mechanic shall consist of three periods as follows:

1. Two periods, each of which shall consist of 1800 hours of classes that provide training and instruction and of on the job work experience.
2. One period of 900 hours of classes that provide training and instruction and of on the job work experience.

(3) Despite subsection (1), in the case of a person who holds a certificate of qualification as a residential air conditioning systems mechanic and who wishes to complete an apprentice training program to become a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic, the apprentice training program shall consist of only three periods as follows:

1. One period of 900 hours of classes that provide training and instruction and of on the job work experience.
2. Two periods, each of which shall consist of 1800 hours of classes that provide training and instruction and of on the job work experience.

(4) An employer shall not establish an apprentice training program unless the program is approved by the Director.

#### **Wages**

5. (1) The rate of wages for an apprentice who is working in an apprentice training program to become a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic shall be no less than the following percentage of the average rate of wages for journeypersons who have received such a certificate and are employed by the employer with whom the apprentice is working:

1. 40 per cent, during the first of the five periods of apprenticeship referred to in subsection 4 (1).
2. 50 per cent, during the second of the five periods of apprenticeship referred to in subsection 4 (1).
3. 60 per cent, during the third of the five periods of apprenticeship referred to in subsection 4 (1).

4. 70 per cent, during the fourth of the five periods of apprenticeship referred to in subsection 4 (1).
5. 80 per cent, during the fifth of the five periods of apprenticeship referred to in subsection 4 (1).

(2) The rate of wages for an apprentice who is working in an apprentice training program to become a residential air conditioning systems mechanic shall be no less than the following percentage of the average rate of wages for journeypersons who have received such a certificate and are employed by the employer with whom the apprentice is working:

1. 40 per cent, during the first of the two periods of apprenticeship referred to in paragraph 1 of subsection 4 (2).
2. 60 per cent, during the second of the two periods of apprenticeship referred to in paragraph 1 of subsection 4 (2).
3. 80 per cent, during the period of apprenticeship referred to in paragraph 2 of subsection 4 (2).

(3) Despite subsection (1), if a person holds a certificate of qualification as a residential air conditioning systems mechanic and begins an apprentice training program described in subsection 4 (3), the rate of wages for the person during his or her apprenticeship shall be no less than the following percentage of the average hourly rate of wages for journeypersons who have received such a certificate and are employed by the employer with whom the apprentice is working:

1. 60 per cent, during the period of apprenticeship referred to in paragraph 1 of subsection 4 (3).
2. 70 per cent, during the first of the two periods of apprenticeship referred to in paragraph 2 of subsection 4 (3).
3. 80 per cent, during the second of the two periods of apprenticeship referred to in paragraph 2 of subsection 4 (3).

(4) The minimum rate of wages established under subsections (1), (2) and (3) apply to all of the apprentice's hours of work, whether for regular daily hours of work or for hours of work in excess of the regular daily hours of work.

#### Number of apprentices

6. (1) If an employer employs no more than seven journeypersons in the certified trade, the number of apprentices in the certified trade who may be employed by the employer shall not exceed the number set out in Column 2 of the Table to this subsection opposite the number of journeypersons employed by the employer and set out in Column 1 of the Table.

(2) If an employer employs more than seven journeypersons in the certified trade, for every three journeypersons employed after the seventh journeyperson, the employer may employ an additional apprentice.

#### Transition

7. (1) A valid certificate of qualification in the certified trade issued before the day this Regulation comes into force shall be deemed on and after that day to be a certificate of qualification in the branch of the certified trade known as refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic.

(2) A valid certificate of apprenticeship in the certified trade issued before the day this Regulation comes into force shall be deemed on and after that day to be a certificate of apprenticeship in the branch of the certified trade known as refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic.

(3) If a contract of apprenticeship in the certified trade was filed with the Director under clause 9 (1) (b) of the Act before the day this Regulation comes into force and is not fully executed on or before that day,

- (a) the contract shall be deemed on and after that day to be a contract of apprenticeship in the branch of the certified trade known as refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic; and
- (b) every reference in the contract to the certified trade shall be deemed on and after that day to be a reference to the branch of the certified trade known as refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanics.

(4) For the purpose of issuing a certificate of apprenticeship under section 16 of the Act on and after the day this Regulation comes into force, a person who completed an apprentice training program in the certified trade before that day

shall be deemed to have completed an apprentice training program in the branch of the certified trade known as refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic.

If the council of a municipality cancels, reduces or refunds taxes under section 357 of the Act for the previous year on an application under clause 357 (1) (a), (b), (c), (d) or (f) of the Act or under section 358 of the Act for the previous year, recalculate the taxes as if the event that caused the cancellation, reduction or refund had occurred on January 1 of the previous year.
4. If the council of a municipality increases taxes under section 359 of the Act for the previous year, recalculate the taxes for the previous year accordingly.
5. If, as a result of an assessment under subsection 32 (2) or section 33 of the *Assessment Act*, the total taxes for municipal and school purposes for the property for the previous year are altered, recalculate the taxes for the previous year as if the alteration had applied to the property for all of the previous year.

(d) the continuous degrees of the horizontal visual field that are required above and below fixation shall be continuous throughout the required continuous degrees along the horizontal meridian.

- (b) a horizontal visual field of at least 120 continuous degrees along the horizontal meridian and at least 15 continuous degrees above and below fixation, with both eyes open and examined together.

**21.1** If the Minister waived a qualification set out in clause 17 (1) (j) or (k) for an applicant for or a holder of a Class A or D driver's licence under this section as it read before July 31, 2006, the Minister may renew the waiver for the holder requesting a renewal of his or her licence if,

- (a) the holder can safely drive motor vehicles in the class authorized to be driven by the class of licence for which a renewal is requested;
- (b) there is no worsening of the condition that would have disqualified the holder had the prior waiver not been granted;
- (c) the holder provides evidence that he or she has successfully completed the tests, procedures and examinations that the Minister may require to demonstrate that the conditions in clauses (a) and (b) are satisfied; and

- (d) the holder does not have a medical condition or disability that requires a Ministerial waiver from the qualifications for obtaining any class of driver's licence prescribed in the Act or the regulations other than the waiver under this section.

**13. Section 21.2 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**21.2** (1) The Minister may waive the qualification set out in clause 18 (2) (b) for an applicant for or a holder of a Class G, G1 or G2 driver's licence if,

- (a) the applicant or holder provides evidence that he or she has successfully completed the tests, procedures and examinations that the Minister may require; and
- (b) the applicant or holder,
- (i) meets all of the other qualifications set out in this Regulation for the applicable class of driver's licence,
  - (ii) has not been able to meet the qualification set out in clause 18 (2) (b) for a period of at least three months immediately before the application,
  - (iii) does not have a medical or visual condition or disability that, alone or combined with a reduced horizontal visual field, may significantly impair his or her ability to drive, including,
    - (A) a neurological deficit or disorder, including epilepsy,
    - (B) diabetes that requires insulin for control,
    - (C) hypotension, or
    - (D) an impairment resulting from dementia, stroke, brain tumour, brain surgery, head trauma or arthritis,
  - (iv) does not have accumulated more than six demerit points on his or her driving record,
  - (v) did not have his or her driver's licence under suspension at any time within the preceding five years pursuant to section 53, subsection 128 (15) or section 130, 172, 200 or 216 of the Act or as a result of a conviction under the *Criminal Code* (Canada) for an offence committed by means of a motor vehicle or while driving or having the care, charge or control of a motor vehicle, and
  - (vi) has not, within the preceding five years and within the period of time he or she has been unable to meet the requirements of clause 18 (2) (b), been involved in a collision the circumstances of which also gave rise to a conviction for contravening or failing to comply with section 128, 136, 138, 140, 141, 147, 148, 154, 156, 158 or 172 or subsection 175 (11) of the Act.

(2) The Minister may revoke a waiver given under subsection (1) at any time if the holder no longer meets the requirements of subclause (1) (b) (i), (iii), (iv), (v) or (vi).

(3) If the applicant's or holder's horizontal visual field is so fragmented or incomplete that the size, shape, nature or relative position of the defects in it or along the horizontal meridian or above or below fixation may significantly impair his or her ability to drive, then the Minister shall not grant the waiver under this section.

**14. Section 22 of the Regulation is amended by striking out the portion before clause (a) and substituting the following:**

**22.** Any class of driver's licence, except a Class G1, G2, M, M1 or M2 driver's licence, is authority for,

**15. Subsection 28 (20) of the Regulation is amended by striking out "or R".**

**16. (1) Clause 29 (1) (a) of the Regulation is amended by striking out the portion before subclause (i) and substituting the following:**

- (a) has held a valid driver's licence, other than a Class G1, G2, M, M1 or M2 driver's licence, issued under the Act,

**(2) Subsection 29 (3) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

(3) Despite subsections (1) and (2), the period of time during which an equivalent licence must be held under those subsections may be reduced by the period of time that the driver held the equivalent of a Class G1 driver's licence, to a maximum of 12 months, and by the period of time that the driver held the equivalent of a Class M1 driver's licence, to a maximum of 60 days.

**(3) Subsection 29 (11) of the Regulation is revoked.**

**17. (1) Clause 30 (1) (a) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

- (a) a temporary Class G1 driver's licence, for a period of up to 90 days;

**(2) Subsection 30 (2) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

(2) A temporary licence under subsection (1) may not be issued for a period beyond the day on which the licence holder is scheduled to take a road test if, on the day he or she schedules the test, he or she holds a Class G1, G2 or M2 driver's licence and the applicable licence expires prior to the day of the road test.

**18. Sections 31 and 32 of the Regulation are revoked.****19. (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Regulation comes into force on May 29, 2005.****(2) Subsection 12 (4) comes into force on July 31, 2006.**

**1. Section 1 of Regulation 1031 of the Revised Regulations of Ontario, 1990 is amended by adding the following definition:**

“video game” means a film that is in the format of an interactive game where the nature or sequence of the visual images may be varied by operation of the device producing the images, which device may include a computer, a gaming system, a console or other technology. (“jeu vidéo”)

**2. The Regulation is amended by adding the following section:**

**2.1** The Board is authorized to adopt as classifications of video games, including for the purposes of this Regulation and subsections 19 (4) and 47 (1) and section 58 of the Act, classifications made by the Entertainment Software Rating Board.

**3. Sections 4 and 5 of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:****4.** The following films are prescribed for the purposes of subsection 19 (4) of the Act:

1. Films that are classified as “restricted”.
2. Video games that the Entertainment Software Rating Board has classified as “mature” or “adults only” if the Board as defined in the Act has adopted those classifications for the purposes of that subsection.

**5.** The following films are prescribed for the purposes of subsection 47 (1) of the Act:

1. Films that are classified as “restricted” or “18A”.
2. Video games that the Entertainment Software Rating Board has classified as “mature” or “adults only” if the Board as defined in the Act has adopted those classifications for the purposes of that subsection.

**4. The Regulation is amended by adding the following section:**

**27.1** A person is exempt from section 40 of the Act if the person carries on the business of a film exchange in which video games are the only class of film that is distributed.

**5. Section 31 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**31.** (1) A video game that the Entertainment Software Rating Board has classified as “mature” or “adults only” and for which the Board as defined in the Act has adopted the classification is exempt from,

- (a) the Act, except for sections 19, 47 and 58; and
- (b) the regulations, except for sections 2.1, 4, 5 and this section of this Regulation.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a video game if it has, as its main object, the depiction of explicit sexual activity and it includes a depiction described in clause 14 (4) (b).

(3) A video game, other than a video game described in subsection (1), is exempt from the Act and the regulations unless it contains one or more scenes of a type described in subsection 28 (3).

**6. This Regulation comes into force on the later of the day subsection 22 (8) of the *Ministry of Consumer and Business Services Statute Law Amendment Act, 2004* comes into force and the day this Regulation is filed.**

## EXEMPTIONS RESPECTING THE ONTARIO FINANCING AUTHORITY

### Definition

1. In this Regulation,

“public body” has the same meaning as in section 29 of the *Capital Investment Plan Act, 1993*.

### Exemption re investment advice

2. The Ontario Financing Authority is not required to be registered under the Act in order to act as an adviser in the provision of investment advice to the Crown in right of Ontario and to public bodies.

### Exemptions re investment pool

3. (1) The Ontario Financing Authority is not required to be registered under the Act in connection with the issue of units of any investment pool that is created by the Authority for the purpose of facilitating investment by the Crown in right of Ontario and by public bodies, if the portfolio securities that comprise the investment pool are restricted to bonds, debentures, commercial paper and other debt instruments in which the Minister of Finance is authorized to invest under the *Financial Administration Act*.

(2) No prospectus is required to be filed under the Act in connection with the issue of units of an investment pool described in subsection (1).
