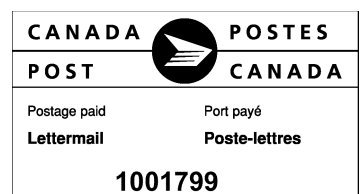

1. Section 1 of Regulation 27 of the Revised Regulations of Ontario, 1990 is amended by adding the following definitions:

“building code” means the building code made under the *Building Code Act, 1992*;

“chief building official” means a chief building official under the *Building Code Act, 1992*;

“design activities” means the activities described in subsection 15.11 (5) of the *Building Code Act, 1992*;

“identifying number” means a number issued by the Registrar under subsection 58 (1) or (2) (authority of member regarding design activities);

“registered code agency” means a registered code agency under the *Building Code Act, 1992*;

“registration number” means a number issued by the Registrar under subsection 56 (1) (authority of holder regarding design activities);

“responsible control” means the degree of control described in section 57;

2. (1) Paragraph 19 of section 42 of the Regulation is amended by striking out “in its entirety under the personal supervision and direction” and substituting “under the responsible control”.

(2) Paragraph 21 of section 42 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

21. Failure of a member or holder to affix his or her seal and signature through the imprint of his or her seal to every design prepared under his or her responsible control and issued or exhibited to a person who is not a holder and is either submitted as part of an application for a building permit or is issued for the construction, enlargement or alteration of a building, except in the case of an open competition in which anonymity is a requirement.

3. (1) Subsection 48 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

(1) Unless exempted by this section, every member and holder shall be insured, by an insurance corporation referred to in subsection 2 (5) of the Act, against errors and omissions arising out of the performance or non-performance of architectural services under a professional liability insurance policy that provides for a liability limit of not less than the following amounts, for each claim with one reinstatement in each policy period,

- (a) \$1,000,000, where the gross fees for architectural services provided by the holder charged in the financial year immediately preceding the year in which the application for or renewal of professional liability insurance is made exceed \$100,000;
- (b) \$500,000, where the gross fees for architectural services provided by the holder charged in the financial year immediately preceding the year in which the application for or renewal of professional liability insurance is made exceed \$50,000 but are \$100,000 or less; or

- (c) \$250,000, where the gross fees for architectural services provided by the holder charged in the financial year immediately preceding the year in which the application for or renewal of professional liability insurance is made are \$50,000 or less.

(1.1) Where a certificate of practice is issued to a holder less than 12 months before the date of the application for professional liability insurance, the minimum liability limits under subsection (1) shall be determined by reference to the estimated gross fees for architectural services provided by the holder for the 12-month period commencing on the date of application.

(1.2) Every professional liability insurance policy obtained under subsection 48 (1) or (1.1) shall provide that,

- (a) the maximum deductible for each claim does not exceed \$100,000;
- (b) any costs or expenses necessarily incurred by the insurance corporation in the investigation, defence or settlement of claims under the policy shall not be part of the liability limit;
- (c) coverage is continued if the insured dies or is adjudged a bankrupt, insolvent or incompetent during the policy period; and
- (d) coverage is subject to such exclusions and conditions and otherwise on such terms as are consistent with normal insurance industry practice from time to time.

(2) Subsection 48 (4) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

(4) Subsections (1) to (1.2) apply to every holder referred to in subsection (3) and every member who is an employee of such a holder.

4. Section 50 of the Regulation is amended by striking out “prescribed under the *Building Code Act, 1992*” at the end of the portion before paragraph 1.

5. The Regulation is amended by adding the following sections:

55. Sections 56 to 65 apply to all holders and members who carry out design activities.

56. (1) A holder may only carry out a design activity in respect of a type of building described in Column 4 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code if,

- (a) the holder is registered and has been issued a registration number by the Registrar authorizing the holder to carry out design activities in the corresponding class of registration in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code, or
- (b) the holder has engaged or entered into a joint venture agreement with another holder that is registered and has been issued a registration number by the Registrar authorizing that holder to carry out design activities in the corresponding class of registration in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code.

(2) An application for registration and registration number shall be in a form provided by the Registrar.

(3) The requirements and qualifications for registration and issuance of a registration number are:

1. Evidence that,

- i. the applicant, or an officer, director, partner or full-time employee of the applicant, is a member who has successfully completed the qualification program published and administered by the Association relating to the member's knowledge of the *Building Code Act, 1992* and the building code in the category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to the class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code for which the application is made, and
- ii. all members exercising responsible control for the design activities provided by the applicant have successfully completed the qualification program published and administered by the Association relating to their knowledge of the *Building Code Act, 1992* and the building code in the category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to the class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code for which the application is made.

2. Payment of all outstanding fees prescribed by the by-laws for any qualification program, if applicable.

3. Payment of the fees prescribed by the by-laws for the application and registration.

(4) A registration and registration number, unless suspended or revoked under subsection 60 (2), or cancelled under section 63, is valid so long as the holder's certificate of practice is valid.

(5) Every holder shall, at the time of an application for registration and registration number or, if a registration number has been issued, on renewal of the certificate of practice issued to the holder provide to the Registrar any documents or information regarding the qualifications of the holder or an officer, director, partner, or full-time employee of the holder, and of any member who exercises responsible control for any design activities provided by the holder, that the Registrar may reasonably require.

- (6) Every registration and registration number issued is subject to the following terms and conditions:
1. The holder shall carry out design activities only in respect to the type of building described in Column 4 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to the class or classes of registration held by the holder.
 2. Where the holder is a corporation or partnership, the holder shall ensure that at least one of the holder's officers, directors, partners or full-time employees is a member that has been issued an identifying number in the categories of qualifications in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that correspond to each class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that is held by the holder, throughout the term of the registration.
 3. Not more than 180 days after the day the Registrar gives notice of a new qualification program relating to a class of registration held by the holder, the holder shall,
 - i. ensure that the holder, and if the holder is a corporation or partnership any of the holder's officers, directors, partners or full-time employees that are members described in paragraph 2, and any member exercising responsible control for design activities provided by the holder in the class of registration to which the notice relates, successfully complete the qualification program, including payment of any fees associated with the qualification program, and
 - ii. provide the names of all persons mentioned in subparagraph i who successfully complete the qualification program, along with the names of the qualification programs that were successfully completed, to the Registrar in such form as the Registrar may require.
 4. The holder shall ensure that a member described in paragraph 2, or another member who is a full-time employee of the holder that has been issued an identifying number in the category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to the class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that is held by the holder to which a design activity provided by the holder relates, exercises responsible control for the design activities in each class of registration that is provided by the holder.
 5. The holder shall ensure that the member who exercises responsible control for the design activities provided by the holder includes the following information on any document submitted to a chief building official or registered code agency whenever a design activity is provided:
 - i. The holder's name and address of record.
 - ii. The holder's registration number.
 - iii. The member's seal and signature.
 6. The holder shall maintain insurance coverage as required under section 48 throughout the term of the registration.

57. Every member shall exercise responsible control in accordance with the guidelines set out in Practice Bulletins A.15, A.15a and A.1d, published by the Association, dated March 14, 2005, accessible on the Association's website, www.oaa.on.ca, and available in printed copies from the Association's head office at 111 Moatfield Drive, Toronto, Ontario, M3B 3L6.

58. (1) A member may only exercise responsible control for design activities provided by a holder if,

- (a) the member has been issued an identifying number by the Registrar authorizing the member to exercise responsible control for design activities for the category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to the class or classes of registration held by the holder; and
- (b) the design activities relate to the type of building described in Column 4 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code for which the member has been issued an identifying number in the corresponding category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code.

(2) A member who is an officer, director, partner or full-time employee of a person who is not a holder may only carry out design activities and exercise responsible control for design activities if the member has been issued an identifying number by the Registrar authorizing the member to carry out design activities and exercise responsible control for design activities for a category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to the type of building described in Column 4 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code to which the design activities relate.

(3) An application for an identifying number shall be in a form provided by the Registrar.

(4) The requirements and qualifications for issuance of an identifying number are:

1. Evidence that the applicant has successfully completed the qualification program or programs published and administered by the Association relating to the applicant's knowledge of the *Building Code Act, 1992* and the building code in the category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that correspond,
 - i. to the class or classes of registration held by the holder for whom the applicant exercises responsible control over design activities, or

- ii. in the case of an applicant who is an officer, director, partner or full-time employee of a person who is not a holder, to the type of building described in Column 4 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code for which the applicant carries out design activities or exercises responsible control for design activities.
- 2. Payment of all outstanding fees prescribed by the by-laws for any qualification program, if applicable.
- 3. Payment of the fees prescribed by the by-laws for the application and identifying number.
- (5) An identifying number, unless suspended or revoked under subsection 60 (2), or cancelled under section 63, is valid so long as the member's licence is valid.
- (6) Every member shall, at the time of an application for an identifying number or, if an identifying number has been issued, on the date of payment of the annual licence fee prescribed by the by-laws provide to the Registrar any documents or information regarding his or her qualifications that the Registrar may reasonably require.
- (7) Every identifying number issued is subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - 1. Not more than 180 days after the day the Registrar gives notice of a new qualification program relating to a category of qualifications held by the member, the member shall,
 - i. successfully complete the qualification program, including payment of any fees associated with the qualification program, and
 - ii. provide his or her name, along with the name of the qualification program that was successfully completed, to the Registrar in such form as the Registrar may require.
 - 2. The member shall ensure that if he or she has exercised responsible control for the design activities provided by a holder or carried out design activities and exercised responsible control for design activities as an officer, director, partner or full-time employee of a person who is not a holder, the following information is included on any document submitted to a chief building official or registered code agency whenever a design activity is provided:
 - i. The member's name and identifying number.
 - ii. The member's seal and signature.
- 59.** Every holder with a registration and registration number, and every member with an identifying number, shall immediately notify the Registrar of any change in any particular contained in an application and shall provide to the Registrar any documents and information that the Registrar may reasonably require.
- 60.** (1) The Registrar may refuse to register and issue a registration number to a holder, or to issue an identifying number to a member, if,
 - (a) the holder or member is in contravention of the *Building Code Act, 1992* or the building code;
 - (b) the holder or member does not meet the requirements and qualifications for registration and a registration number or an identifying number;
 - (c) the holder's certificate of practice or the member's licence has been suspended, revoked or cancelled;
 - (d) an order has been made under subsection 69 (2) of the *Provincial Offences Act* directing that no registration and registration number or identifying number be granted or issued to the holder or member until a fine is paid;
 - (e) in the case of a holder, the Registrar is of the opinion that the past conduct of the holder or an officer, director, partner or full-time employee of the holder affords reasonable grounds that the holder or officer, director, partner or full-time employee of the holder will not carry out design activities in accordance with the law; or
 - (f) in the case of a member, the Registrar is of the opinion that the past conduct of the member affords reasonable grounds that the member will not carry out design activities in accordance with the law or exercise responsible control for design activities.
- (2) The Registrar may suspend or revoke a holder's registration and registration number or a member's identifying number if,
 - (a) the holder or member is in contravention of the *Building Code Act, 1992* or the building code;
 - (b) the holder or member no longer meets the requirements and qualifications for a registration and registration number or an identifying number;
 - (c) the holder or member is in breach of a term or condition of a registration and registration number or an identifying number;
 - (d) the registration and registration number or identifying number were granted or issued to the holder or member on the basis of mistaken, false or incorrect information;
 - (e) the holder's certificate of practice or the member's licence has been suspended, revoked or cancelled;

- (f) an order has been made under subsection 69 (2) of the *Provincial Offences Act* directing that the holder's registration and registration number, or the member's identifying number, be suspended until a fine is paid;
- (g) in the case of a holder, the Registrar is of the opinion that the past conduct of the holder or an officer, director, partner or full-time employee of the holder affords reasonable grounds that the holder or officer, director, partner or full-time employee of the holder will not carry out design activities in accordance with the law; or
- (h) in the case of a member, the Registrar is of the opinion that the past conduct of the member affords reasonable grounds that the member will not carry out design activities in accordance with the law or exercise responsible control for design activities.

(3) Where the Registrar refuses to register and issue a registration number to a holder or issue an identifying number to a member under subsection (1), or suspends or revokes a registration and registration number or identifying number under subsection (2), the Registrar shall serve a notice of the proposal, together with written reasons, on the holder or member.

(4) A notice under subsection (3) shall state that the holder or member is entitled to a hearing before the Building Code Qualifications Committee established under section 61 if the holder or member serves, within 15 days after the notice under subsection (3) is served on the holder or member, notice in writing on the Registrar requiring a hearing.

(5) Where the holder or member does not require a hearing before the Building Code Qualifications Committee in accordance with subsection (4), the Registrar may carry out the proposal stated in the notice under subsection (3).

61. (1) The Building Code Qualifications Committee is established.

(2) The Building Code Qualifications Committee shall be composed of,

- (a) at least two elected members of the Council appointed at pleasure to the Committee by the Council; and
- (b) at least two members of the Association who are not members of the Council and who are appointed at pleasure to the Committee by the Council.

(3) Three members of the Building Code Qualifications Committee, one of whom is an elected member of the Council, constitute a quorum.

(4) A determination of the Building Code Qualifications Committee made in a meeting or a hearing of the Committee requires the vote of a majority of the members of the Committee who are present at the meeting, including those members who are deemed to be present at a meeting under paragraph 7 of subsection 8 (1) of the Act.

(5) The Council shall appoint one member of the Building Code Qualifications Committee, who is an elected member of the Council, to be the chair of the Committee.

(6) The chair or, in the absence of the chair, a member of the Building Code Qualifications Committee designated by the chair shall preside at all meetings and hearings of the Committee.

62. (1) Where the holder or member requires a hearing by the Building Code Qualifications Committee in accordance with subsection 60 (4), the Committee shall appoint a time for, give notice of and shall hold the hearing.

(2) Following a hearing under subsection (1), the Building Code Qualifications Committee may, by order, direct the Registrar to carry out the proposal, refrain from carrying out the proposal, or take any action that the Committee considers in accordance with the purpose and intent of this section, and for such purposes the Committee may substitute its opinion for that of the Registrar.

(3) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the provisions of the Act applying to hearings by the Registration Committee, except section 36, apply with necessary modifications to proceedings of the Building Code Qualifications Committee.

63. The Registrar may, upon written request of a holder or member, cancel a registration and registration number or identifying number.

64. (1) The Registrar shall maintain a list of holders that are registered and have been issued a registration number for each class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that contains the following information:

1. The holder's name and address of record.
2. The holder's registration number.
3. The qualifications of the holder and the officers, directors, partners and full-time employees of the holder in each category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that corresponds to each class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code.

(2) The Registrar shall maintain a list of members with an issued identifying number for each category of qualifications set out in Column 3 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code that contains the following information:

1. The member's name and identifying number.

2. The member's qualifications.

3. Where the member carries out design activities for a holder, the holder's name, address of record and registration number in each class of registration set out in Column 2 of Table 2.20.2.1 of the building code.

(3) The Registrar shall remove the name of a holder or member from the list under subsection (1) or (2) if the holder's registration and registration number, or the member's identifying number, is suspended or revoked under subsection 60 (2), or cancelled under section 63.

65. 1. (1) Paragraph 3 of subsection 3 (1) of Ontario Regulation 201/96 is revoked and the following substituted:

3. In order to become eligible, an application to become enrolled must be made to the Minister on behalf of the person's household unit and the Minister must be satisfied that the members of the household unit have collectively spent the amount determined in accordance with sections 4, 4.1 and 4.2, or more, on allowable expenses in any quarter in a fiscal period.

(2) Subsection 3 (3) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

(3) Subject to subsection (3.1), an application under paragraph 3 of subsection (1) shall be made in the form provided by the Minister and must include,

- (a) receipts for allowable expenses as required by the form;
- (b) information evidencing annual net income as required by the form; and
- (c) completion of the consents required by the form.

(3.1) Every application made under paragraph 3 of subsection (1) shall be deemed to be renewed every year, effective as of the first day of the fiscal period, unless,

- (a) the Minister confirms that no claims for payment were submitted to the Health Network mentioned in section 23 on behalf of any member of the household unit for one fiscal period;
- (b) the member of the household unit that made the application on behalf of the household unit notifies the Minister that all members of the household unit withdraw the general consent required by the application form; or
- (c) the member of the household unit that made the application requests that the Minister terminate the enrolment of all members of the household unit.

(3.2) If a person's application is not renewed for one of the reasons set out in subsection (3.1), the person may reapply to be enrolled by completing the application form required by paragraph 3 of subsection (1) in accordance with subsection (3).

(3.3) The member of the household unit that made the application shall notify the Minister in writing of any change in the unit's circumstances or membership that results in a member of the household unit ceasing to be a member of the eligible class of persons, or of any other changes that may affect the calculation of the unit's allowable expenses under section 4, 4.1 or 4.2.

2. (1) Subsection 4 (3) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

(3) For the purposes of this section, a member's most recent taxation year is the member's taxation year that ended before the beginning of the fiscal period in respect of which an application is made under paragraph 3 of subsection 3 (1) or renewed under subsection 3 (3.1).

(2) Subsections 4 (6) and (7) of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:

(6) In the case of an election under subsection (5), if the relevant taxation year of a member of a household unit is not complete on the day the application to be enrolled is made or the day upon which the Minister receives the member's written notification of his or her election, whichever is later, the member's annual net income for that taxation year shall be determined using the sum of,

- (a) the member's income from the beginning of the taxation year until the day of the application or the Minister's receipt of the notification of election; and
- (b) an estimate of the member's income from the day of the application or the Minister's receipt of the notification of election until the end of the taxation year.

(7) An estimate under clause (6) (b) shall be determined by multiplying the number of days remaining in the member's taxation year by the member's average daily income for the month immediately preceding the day of the application or receipt of notification.

3. Clause 4.1 (1) (b) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

- (b) in the quarter immediately preceding the quarter in respect of which eligibility is being determined, the members of the person's household unit spent less on allowable expenses than the amount determined under subsection 4 (1).

4. Subsection 4.2 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:

(1) If the application made under paragraph 3 of subsection 3 (1) in any given fiscal period requests that eligibility begin after the beginning of the period, the amount referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3 of subsection 3 (1) that must be spent on allowable expenses in each remaining quarter of the fiscal period shall be determined in accordance with subsection (2).

5. This Regulation comes into force on July 31, 2005.

ONTARIO REGULATION 157/05

DOG OWNERS' LIABILITY ACT

Made: March 30, 2005

Filed: March 30, 2005

PIT BULL CONTROLS

GENERAL

Control of pit bulls

1. (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), an owner of a restricted pit bull shall ensure that the pit bull is at all times equipped with a muzzle and secured by a leash in accordance with subsection (5).

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply when a pit bull is within enclosed property occupied by the owner of the pit bull.

(3) When a pit bull is within enclosed property occupied by a person who consents to the pit bull being off leash or off muzzle, subsection (1) does not apply to the extent of that consent.

(4) For the purposes of subsections (2) and (3), a pit bull is within enclosed property when the property is enclosed in a way that can be relied on to prevent the pit bull from breaking out of the property.

(5) For the purposes of subsection (1), a pit bull shall be equipped with a muzzle and secured by a leash in accordance with the following rules:

1. The pit bull shall be fitted with a collar or harness that is properly fitted to and placed on the dog.
2. The movement of the pit bull shall be controlled by a person by means of a leash attached to the collar or harness on the pit bull.
3. The leash is not more than 1.8 metres in length and is attached to the collar or harness.
4. The collar or harness, the leash and the attachment between the leash and the collar or harness are all strong enough to prevent the pit bull from breaking any of them.
5. The mouth of the pit bull is covered by a muzzle that is humane and that is strong enough and well-fitted enough to prevent the pit bull from biting, without interfering with the breathing, panting or vision of the pit bull or with the pit bull's ability to drink.

(6) Every owner of a pit bull shall ensure that the requirements of this section are complied with on and after the day that is 60 days after the day on which this Regulation comes into force.

Sterilization

2. (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), every owner of a restricted pit bull shall ensure that the pit bull is sterilized by a veterinarian on or before the day that is 60 days after the day on which this Regulation comes into force.

(2) If the effect of subsection (1) would be to require sterilization of a pit bull before it reaches the age of 36 weeks, every owner of the pit bull shall instead ensure that it is sterilized on or before the day on which it reaches that age.

(3) An owner of a restricted pit bull is exempt from complying with subsection (1) if, in the written opinion of a veterinarian, the pit bull is physically unfit to be anaesthetized because of old age or infirmity.

(4) If a veterinarian gives a written opinion based on infirmity, the veterinarian shall state, in the written opinion, whether, in his or her opinion, the infirmity may not be permanent.

(5) Where the veterinarian states that an infirmity may not be permanent, he or she shall specify, in the written opinion, a date by which the owner should have the pit bull re-examined by a veterinarian to determine whether the pit bull is fit to be anaesthetized.

(6) An exemption based on a written opinion that specifies a date under subsection (5) ends on that date, but a further written opinion under subsection (3) may be sought in respect of the pit bull on or before that date.

(7) In this section,

“veterinarian” means a member of the College of Veterinarians of Ontario.

DOG SHOWS

Approved dog shows

3. (1) In this section and sections 4 and 5,

“dog show” includes a conformation show, an agility trial, an obedience trial, a tracking test and an earth dog test.

(2) For the purposes of sections 4 and 5, a dog show is an approved dog show if it is an event, whether held in Ontario or elsewhere, that is sanctioned, in writing, by one or more of the following dog registries:

1. The Canadian Kennel Club.
2. The United Kennel Club.
3. The American Kennel Club.
4. The American Dog Breeders Association.

Exemptions, restricted pit bulls

4. (1) The exemptions set out in subsection (3) apply in respect of restricted pit bulls within the meaning of subsection 7 (1) of the Act, as long as the conditions set out in subsection (2) are met.

(2) The following are the conditions referred to in subsection (1):

1. The restricted pit bull is registered as a Staffordshire bull terrier, an American Staffordshire terrier or an American pit bull terrier with one or more of the dog registries named in subsection 3 (2).
2. The owner of the restricted pit bull has given written notice to one of the dog registries named in subsection 3 (2) stating the owner's intention that the restricted pit bull participate in approved dog shows.
3. Except in the circumstances described in paragraph 4, the restricted pit bull has participated in at least one approved dog show during the 365-day period ending on the day this Regulation comes into force.
4. In the case of a restricted pit bull that was unborn or below the age of 36 weeks on the day this Regulation comes into force, the pit bull has participated in at least one approved dog show during the period ending on the day on which the pit bull reaches the age of 36 weeks.
5. The restricted pit bull has participated in an approved dog show at least once in every 365-day period since the dog's first participation in such a show during the period that applies to the pit bull under paragraph 3 or 4, as the case may be.

(3) The following are the exemptions referred to in subsection (1):

1. The requirements of subsections 1 (1), (5) and (6) do not apply while the pit bull is on the site of and participating in an approved dog show.
2. The requirements of section 2 do not apply.

Exemptions, pit bulls not owned by Ontario residents

5. (1) The exemptions set out in subsection (3) apply in respect of pit bulls that are not owned by a resident of Ontario, as long as the conditions set out in subsection (2) are met.

(2) The following are the conditions referred to in subsection (1):

1. The pit bull is registered as a Staffordshire bull terrier, an American Staffordshire terrier or an American pit bull terrier with one or more of the dog registries named in subsection 3 (2).
2. The owner of the pit bull has given written notice to one of the dog registries named in subsection 3 (2) stating the owner's intention that the pit bull participate in approved dog shows.
3. Beginning on the day on which this Regulation comes into force, the pit bull has not been present in Ontario except during 14-day periods that include an approved dog show in which the pit bull participated.

(3) The following are the exemptions referred to in subsection (1):

1. Subsections 1 (1), (5) and (6) do not apply while the pit bull is on the site of and participating in an approved dog show.
2. Section 2 does not apply.
3. Clause 6 (a) of the Act does not apply during the 14-day periods mentioned in paragraph 3 of subsection (2).
4. Clause 6 (f) of the Act does not apply if the pit bull is brought into Ontario within the 14-day period preceding an approved dog show in Ontario and the dog is registered as a participant in that show.

Interpretation

6. Nothing in section 4 or 5 of this Regulation shall be interpreted as a limit on the prohibition, in clause 6 (b) of the Act, against breeding pit bulls.

Commencement

7. **This Regulation comes into force on August 29, 2005.**

3. La laisse ne dépasse pas 1,8 mètre et est attachée au collier ou au harnais.
4. Le collier ou le harnais, la laisse et le dispositif d'attache de la laisse au collier ou au harnais sont tous suffisamment solides pour empêcher le pit-bull de les rompre.

TAX MATTERS — REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF PEEL**Designation**

1. The Regional Municipality of Peel is designated for 2005 for the purposes of section 310 of the Act.

Delegation

2. (1) If The Regional Municipality of Peel passes a by-law under section 310 of the Act delegating the authority to establish tax ratios for 2005 to its lower-tier municipalities, a lower-tier municipality shall, for 2005,

- (a) use the tax ratios it establishes to calculate, with respect to each local municipality levy of the lower-tier municipality under section 312 of the Act, a separate tax rate on the assessment in each property class in the lower-tier municipality rateable for purposes of the local municipality levy; and
- (b) establish and levy, with respect to each upper-tier levy of The Regional Municipality of Peel under section 311 of the Act, a separate tax rate on the assessment in each property class in the lower-tier municipality rateable for purposes of the upper-tier levy sufficient to raise the lower-tier municipality's portion of the upper-tier levy calculated under section 3.

(2) The tax rates the lower-tier municipality establishes under clause (1) (b) must be in the same proportion to each other as the tax ratios established by the lower-tier municipality for the property classes are to each other.

(3) Subsections 311 (7) to (9) and (22) to (25) of the Act apply with necessary modifications to the tax rates established by the lower-tier municipality under clause (1) (b) as if the lower-tier municipality were an upper-tier municipality.

(4) An upper-tier levy by-law of The Regional Municipality of Peel under section 311 of the Act shall set out a lower-tier municipality's portion of an upper-tier levy calculated under section 3 and shall not establish tax rates to be levied by the lower-tier municipality to raise the lower-tier municipality's portion.

Portion to be raised

3. For the purposes of the upper-tier levy or any special upper-tier levy of The Regional Municipality of Peel under section 311 of the Act, the portion to be raised in each lower-tier municipality shall be as follows:

Mississauga	64.19577%
Brampton	30.80236%
Caledon	5.00187%

Deadline extended

4. The last day for making a designation under clause 310 (10) (a) of the Act is extended to the day this Regulation is filed.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT IN DEFINED INDUSTRIES — MINERAL EXPLORATION AND MINING

Definitions

1. In this Regulation,

“defined industries” means the mineral exploration industry and the mining industry;

“mineral exploration” means prospecting, staking or exploration for minerals and any related activities, and includes,

- (a) advanced exploration such as the excavation of an exploratory shaft, adit or decline, the extraction of minerals for the purpose of proving a mineral deposit, and the installation of a mill for test purposes, and
- (b) site rehabilitation;

“mining” means the extraction, concentration and smelting of economic minerals from a mineral deposit for commercial purposes, and “mine” has a corresponding meaning.

Scope

2. (1) This Regulation is restricted in its application to,

- (a) employees in the mineral exploration industry who work at sites of mineral exploration, subject to subsection (2);
- (b) employees in the mining industry who,
 - (i) work at mines, and
 - (ii) during periods of consecutive days of work, do not live at their principal residences but instead live in bunkhouses, hotels or motels, or other temporary accommodation; and
- (c) employers of the employees described in clauses (a) and (b).

(2) Clause (1) (a) does not apply to an employee whose employer’s principal business is mining.

Terms and conditions of employment

3. This Regulation sets out terms and conditions of employment that apply to employees and employers described in section 2.

Days free from work

4. (1) If the employer and the employee agree, subsections (2) and (3) apply instead of subsection 18 (4) of the Act.
- (2) The employer shall not require or permit the employee to perform work on more than 28 consecutive days.
- (3) The employer shall give the employee days free from work in accordance with the following:
1. The number of days free from work shall be equal to the number of consecutive days on which the employee worked before the period of days free from work, divided by three.
 2. Despite paragraph 1, if dividing by three under that paragraph produces a mixed number, the number of days free from work shall be the next higher whole number.
 3. If the employee is entitled to more than one day free from work, those days shall be consecutive, and all of them shall be given before the employee returns to work.

1. Section 18 of Ontario Regulation 145/04 is revoked and the following substituted:**ISA levels 2 and 3 amount**

18. The ISA levels 2 and 3 amount for a board is determined as follows:

1. Take the sum of the amounts determined in respect of the board under subsections 17 (2) and 18 (2) of the 2003-2004 grant regulation.
2. Subtract the greatest of the following amounts:
 - i. The amount determined using the following formula:

$$((A - B) - C) - (0.04 \times D)$$

in which,

“A” is the amount that was in the board’s special education reserve fund on August 31, 2003,

“B” is the amount, if any, that was in the board’s special education reserve fund on August 31, 2003, that was not required to be placed in that reserve fund under section 41 of Ontario Regulation 156/02 or a predecessor of that section,

“C” is the greater of zero and the difference between,

(a) the amount that would have been determined under subsection 42 (3) of the 2003-2004 grant regulation if that amount had been determined on the basis of the board’s expenditures on special education that the board had authorized by motions passed before July 1, 2004 or that it had otherwise decided, before July 1, 2004, that it would make in the 2003-2004 fiscal year, and

(b) the special education allocation for the board determined under section 14 of the 2003-2004 grant regulation, and

“D” is the amount that was determined in respect of the board under clause 17 (b) of Ontario Regulation 156/02.

ii. The amount determined using the following formula:

$$E - (0.02 \times F)$$

in which,

“E” is the amount that was in the board’s special education reserve fund on August 31, 2004, and

“F” is the sum of the ISA level 2 claim and the ISA level 3 claim determined in respect of the board under subsections 17 (2) and 18 (2), respectively, of the 2003-2004 grant regulation.

iii. Zero.

3. Add the amount determined as follows:

i. Take the number of pupils who were enrolled in a school operated by the board on October 31, 2004, who were not enrolled in a school operated by the board on October 31, 2003 and who, in the opinion of the Minister, meet one of the following criteria:

A. The pupil was enrolled in a class in which there was no less than one adult assigned for every four students where the adult was employed in special education programs and was a teacher, teaching assistant, professional or paraprofessional within the meaning of Appendix H of the 2004-05 School Board Estimates, dated May 26, 2004.

B. The full-time equivalent of at least one teaching assistant, professional or paraprofessional within the meaning of Appendix H of the 2004-05 School Board Estimates, dated May 26, 2004 was assigned to the pupil for, on average, no less than one-half of each instructional day in the 2004-2005 school year.

ii. Subtract the number of pupils who meet both of the following criteria. If the difference is a negative number, the number determined under this paragraph is zero:

A. The pupil is a pupil in respect of whom an ISA level 2 claim or an ISA level 3 claim was approved within the meaning of subsections 17 (1) and 18 (1), respectively, of the 2003-2004 grant regulation.

B. The pupil is not enrolled in a school of the board on October 31, 2004.

iii. Multiply the number determined under subparagraph ii by \$17,000.

iv. Calculate the sum of the amounts determined under subparagraph iii for all boards.

v. If the amount determined under subparagraph iv is equal to or less than \$62 million, the amount determined under this paragraph is the amount determined under subparagraph iii. If the amount determined under subparagraph iv is greater than \$62 million, the amount determined under this paragraph is the amount determined by,

A. multiplying the amount determined under subparagraph iii by \$62 million, and

B. dividing the amount determined under sub-subparagraph A by the amount determined under subparagraph iv.

1. Ontario Regulation 511/01 is amended by adding the following section:

Waiver of payment of fee

9. (1) The payment of the fee payable under section 3 for a birth certificate or replacement birth certificate is waived for a homeless or marginally-housed individual in Ontario whose application for a birth certificate or replacement birth certificate is forwarded to the office of the Registrar General by a corporation that meets the requirements set out in subsection (2).

(2) The corporation referred to in subsection (1) must meet the following requirements:

1. The corporation must be a non-profit corporation.
2. The corporation must have a mandate to assist homeless or marginally-housed individuals in Ontario to obtain a birth certificate or replacement birth certificate, in order to assist those individuals to access necessary services such as health care, shelter, housing, food, mental health services and social assistance.
3. There must be no other public funding available to the corporation for the payment of the fee for the birth certificate or replacement birth certificate.

4. The corporation must be a party to an agreement with the Deputy Registrar General for a definite term, under which the corporation agrees that,
 - i. the corporation will not seek the waiver of the payment of the fee for a birth certificate or replacement birth certificate for an individual, unless it believes that the individual is homeless or marginally-housed and that the individual needs the birth certificate or replacement birth certificate in order to assist the individual to access necessary services such as health care, shelter, housing, food, mental health services and social assistance,
 - ii. the corporation will not disclose to anyone other than the office of the Registrar General the identity of, or any other personal information about, an individual whose application for a birth certificate or replacement birth certificate the corporation forwards to the office of the Registrar General, unless the corporation first obtains the written consent of the individual or a person authorized to consent on behalf of the individual,
 - iii. the corporation will permit the Deputy Registrar General or a person designated by the Deputy Registrar General to enter the offices of the corporation for the purpose of making inspections and inquiries in order to determine whether the corporation is complying with the agreement, and
 - iv. the Deputy Registrar General may terminate the agreement if the Deputy Registrar General believes that the corporation does not meet a requirement in paragraph 1, 2 or 3 or has not complied with subparagraph i, ii or iii.
- (3) Subsection (1) does not waive the payment of any surcharge payable under section 8.
- (4) This section is revoked on March 31, 2006.
