Notice of Proposed Regulation Under the Local Health System Integration Act, 2006 French Language Health Services Advisory Council

Introduction

The Minister of Health and Long-Term Care on behalf of the Government of Ontario invites public comments on a proposed regulation under the *Local Health System Integration Act, 2006*.

The Act requires the Minister to establish a French language health services advisory council to advise the Minister about health and service delivery issues related to francophone communities and priorities and strategies for the provincial strategic plan related to those communities. The Lieutenant Governor in Council is authorized under the Act to make a regulation concerning the member organizations of the council.

Under the Act, the Minister is required to publish a notice of the proposed regulation in the *Ontario Gazette*, give notice of the proposed regulation and allow at least 60 days for public comment.

Overview of the Legislation

The *Local Health System Integration Act, 2006* received Royal Assent on March 28, 2006. The legislation establishes an integrated health system to improve the health of Ontarians through better access to health services, coordinated health care and effective and efficient management of the health system at the local level by local health integration networks (LHINs).

Proposed Regulation under the *Local Health System Integration Act, 2006*

The proposed regulation lists the organizations from which the council members would be selected. Under the proposed regulation, the members of the French language health services advisory council would be representatives of the following organizations:

- Alliance des réseaux ontariens de santé en français (representing French language health services networks);
- Assemblée de la francophonie de l'Ontario (representing francophone Ontarians);

- Association française des municipalités de l'Ontario (representing francophone municipalities);
- Fédération des aînés et des retraités francophones de l'Ontario (representing francophone seniors);
- Groupe francophone de l'Association des centres de santé de l'Ontario (representing francophone Community Health Centres);
- Regroupement des intervenantes et intervenants francophones en santé et en services sociaux de l'Ontario (representing health and social service professionals);
- Union Provinciale des Minorités Raciales et Ethnoculturelles Francophones de l'Ontario (representing francophone racial minorities).

The French language health services advisory council would have a provincial scope and would be advisory to the Minister.

The Council's mandate could include providing advice on specific health needs, priorities, strategies and performance measures for the French community. Council members would represent views of the francophone community, they could prepare reports and analyze research or information and / or make the Minister aware of any critical issues emerging in their community. The mandate of the Council and role of Council members will not be included in the regulation; these will be addressed in operational policy.

A copy of the proposed regulation is attached as Schedule "A."

When preparing your response, please consider whether the proposed organizations listed in the regulation should be included in the final regulation or if other organizations should be included.
