1. Section 12 of Ontario Regulation 225/10 is revoked and the following substituted:

BOARD APPROVAL OF DELEGATION BY PRINCIPAL

Board approval

12. (1) A board may by resolution give approval to a principal to delegate some or all of his or her duties related to the operation of extended day programs to persons other than a vice-principal if the delegation is in accordance with the following:

1. The delegation is to,
 - i. a person appointed by a board under paragraph 5.1 of subsection 171 (1) of the Act to supervise persons in positions designated by the board as requiring an early childhood educator,
 - ii. a person appointed by a board under subsection 260 (2) of the Act to an early childhood educator position in an extended day program unit that is designated as requiring an early childhood educator, or
 - iii. a person who the principal considers able to fulfil the duties responsibly.
2. The duties delegated to a person described in subparagraph 1 iii may only be exercised in the event of an emergency and if,
 - i. no person described in subparagraph 1 i or ii is available, and
 - ii. there is no vice-principal employed in the principal's school or there is a vice-principal employed in the principal's school and the principal has already delegated the duties to be delegated to the vice-principal but he or she is not available.
3. A delegation under subparagraph 1 iii shall be for a temporary period that the principal considers appropriate in the circumstances.
4. A delegation under subparagraph 1 iii shall comply with guidelines, if any, established by the board under subsection (2).

(2) A board may establish guidelines respecting the categories of persons who may be delegates under subparagraph 1 iii of subsection (1).

(3) The board's approval shall require that a delegation by a principal be in writing and include the following:

1. The name of the individual appointed as a delegate.
2. The scope of a delegation, including the duties being delegated and any conditions on the exercise of those duties.

3. The duration of the delegation.

4. Any other matter that the board considers should be included in writing in the delegation.

(4) Despite subsection (3), in the case of a delegation under subparagraph 1 iii of subsection (1), the matters referred to in paragraphs 1 to 4 of subsection (3) may be specified orally at the time of the delegation and confirmed in writing by the principal within such time period as the board may specify.

(5) A board's approval shall include directions respecting a principal's duty to monitor the manner in which delegates fulfil their duties.

(6) A board's approval shall require the principal to ensure that any board policy governing emergency procedures, including emergency notifications, is readily available to every person to whom the principal delegates duties.

(7) A board's approval shall require principals to provide copies of delegations and confirmations to such persons as the board may specify.

APPOINTMENTS — EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATORS

Appointment to early childhood educator positions, urgent situations

13. (1) Subject to section 14, where no early childhood educator is available, a board may appoint, to an extended day program position designated by the board as requiring an early childhood educator, a person who is not,

(a) an early childhood educator; or

(b) a person authorized by a letter of permission to be appointed to a position designated by the board as requiring an early childhood educator.

(2) A person appointed under subsection (1) shall be 18 years of age or older and hold an Ontario secondary school diploma, a secondary school graduation diploma or a secondary school honour graduation diploma, or an equivalent to any of them.

(3) An appointment under this section is valid for 10 school days commencing with the day on which the person is appointed.

(4) A board shall submit an annual report to the Minister, and any additional reports that the Minister may require, about appointments made under this section.

(5) A report shall address such matters as the Minister may specify and shall be submitted within the time and in the form that the Minister may specify.

Appointment to early childhood educator positions, urgent or letter of permission

14. (1) A board shall not appoint a person to an extended day program position designated by the board as requiring an early childhood educator under section 13, or in accordance with a letter of permission, if the person is or has ever been a member of the College of Early Childhood Educators.

(2) A board shall not appoint a person to an extended day program position designated by the board as requiring an early childhood educator under section 13, or in accordance with a letter of permission, unless the person has provided to the board a written statement that any early childhood education certificate or licence granted to him or her by another jurisdiction is not cancelled, suspended or revoked for any reason other than failure to pay fees or levies to the governing body.

Certificate cancelled, revoked or suspended

15. A person whose early childhood education certificate of registration is cancelled, revoked or suspended by the College of Early Childhood Educators shall not be appointed to an extended day program position designated by a board as requiring an early childhood educator.

 - (B) was published on a publicly accessible website approved by the Minister, other than a website described in subclause (iv), for at least 10 days and was not removed before the closing date of the competition for the position,
 - (iii) every day that the advertisement appeared in a newspaper or on a website referred to in subclause (ii) was within the 30 days before the closing date of the competition for the position,
 - (iv) the advertisement was made available at two or more universities, colleges of applied arts and technology or private career colleges registered under the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*, that are in Ontario and offer diploma or degree programs in early childhood education,
 - (A) by posting it on a job posting website or electronic bulletin board, approved by the Minister, of a university, college of applied arts and technology or private career college for at least 10 days and it was not removed before the closing date of the competition for the position, or
 - (B) if a university, college of applied arts and technology or private career college is likely to be a source of candidates for the position, as indicated by factors such as the geographic location of the program, the language of instruction of the program or the location of practicum sites for students in the program, but the university, college of applied arts and technology or private career college does not have a job posting website or electronic bulletin board, by submitting the advertisement to the head of department of the early childhood education program,
 - (v) every day that the advertisement appeared on a website or electronic bulletin board referred to in subclause (iv) was within the 30 days before the closing date of the competition for the position,
 - (vi) no early childhood educator has applied for the position or no early childhood educator who has applied for the position has accepted it,
 - (vii) the individual that the board proposes to employ under the authority of a letter of permission is 18 years of age or older and holds an Ontario secondary school diploma, a secondary school graduation diploma or a secondary school honour graduation diploma, or an equivalent to any of them,
 - (viii) the individual is not and has never been a member of the College of Early Childhood Educators,
 - (ix) the individual has provided to the board a written statement that any early childhood education certificate or licence granted to him or her by another jurisdiction is not cancelled, revoked or suspended for any reason other than for failure to pay fees or levies to the governing body,

- (x) the board has collected a personal criminal history, as defined in Ontario Regulation 521/01 (Collection of Personal Information) made under the Act, of the individual,
 - (xi) the board has conducted a reference check of the individual and is satisfied with the results,
 - (xii) if one letter of permission has previously been granted under this Regulation in respect of the individual, the individual has provided the board with documentation indicating that he or she is doing, or will do during the time that the letter of permission is effective, everything that is reasonably necessary to meet the qualifications required to be an early childhood educator, and the board is satisfied with that documentation and information, and
 - (xiii) if two or more letters of permission have previously been granted under this Regulation in respect of the individual, the individual has provided the board with documentation indicating that he or she,
 - (A) has made progress towards meeting the qualifications required to be an early childhood educator since the date that the most recent letter of permission was granted, and the board is satisfied with that documentation and information, or
 - (B) has been unable to make progress as described in sub-subclause (A) for any reason including, but not limited to, pregnancy, parental leave, illness or disability, and the board is satisfied with that documentation and information;
 - (b) the person submitting the application attaches to the application such evidence as the Minister may require of the facts set out in the declaration under clause (a);
 - (c) the application and evidence are submitted no earlier than seven days after the closing date of the competition for the position; and
 - (d) the anticipated start date of the position for which the board proposes to employ the individual is no later than 30 days after the closing date of the competition for the position.
- (2) If a letter of permission is granted, it shall be effective as of the start date of the position.
- (3) An individual may not be employed under the authority of a letter of permission granted under this Regulation for more than four years in total.

(Possession, Buying and Selling of Wildlife)

1. The definition of “cervid” in section 1 of Ontario Regulation 666/98 is revoked and the following substituted:

“cervid” means a member of a species of the deer family;

2. The Regulation is amended by adding the following section:

30.1 (1) For the purposes of section 53 of the Act, a permit is required for the transport by any person of a live woodland caribou, white-tailed deer, American elk or moose into Ontario, whether or not the animal is intended to be kept as a farmed animal.

(2) The Minister shall not issue a permit referred to in subsection (1) to a person unless,

- (a) the person provides the Minister with a written notice issued by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs and described in subsection (3), and
 - (b) the qualifications described in subsection (4) are met.
- (3) A notice issued by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs shall indicate that that minister is satisfied that the animal being transported into Ontario,
- (a) is from a herd that,
 - (i) participates in a chronic wasting disease surveillance programme established in the herd's home jurisdiction, and
 - (ii) is certified by a qualified veterinarian in accordance with that programme; and
 - (b) is unlikely to be at risk of spreading chronic wasting disease based on,
 - (i) a qualified veterinarian's assessment of the animal's health, and
 - (ii) the animal's history of movement over the last 36 months.
- (4) It is a qualification for any permit for the transport into Ontario of a live woodland caribou, white-tailed deer, American elk or moose that the animal being transported be delivered to,
- (a) a place for slaughtering in which the animal is slaughtered immediately upon arrival; or
 - (b) a place of captivity that meets the requirements set out in subsection (5).
- (5) A place of captivity to which a live woodland caribou, white-tailed deer, American elk or moose is delivered must have adopted the following measures in order to prevent the introduction and spread of disease:
1. The place has a two gate system through which vehicles transporting animals must pass before the animals are released and the gates are separated by sufficient space so as to allow vehicles to stop between the gates as the first gate is being shut and the second gate is being opened.
 2. The place is enclosed by a system of double fencing that is designed to prevent a captive woodland caribou, white-tailed deer, American elk or moose from escaping or has one of the following means of preventing such animals from escaping that is as effective as a system of double fencing:
 - i. The place is enclosed by a single fence and a system of electrified fencing.
 - ii. The place is enclosed by a single fence that is sufficiently high and solid to prevent the animals from escaping.
 - iii. The place has a system of landscaping arrangements and natural barriers that are sufficient to prevent the animals from escaping.
 3. The place ensures that all captive woodland caribou, white-tailed deer, American elk or moose that are kept in the place are identified with a unique number.
- 3. This Regulation comes into force on the later of July 1, 2010 and the day it is filed.**

Regional Municipality of York — Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville

2. That part of the King’s Highway known as No. 48 in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in The Regional Municipality of York lying between a point situate 300 metres measured southerly from its intersection with the centre line of the roadway known as Sam’s Way and a point situate 300 metres measured northerly from its intersection with the centre line of the roadway known as Hoover Park Drive.

(4) Part 5 of Schedule 53 to the Regulation is amended by adding the following paragraph:

Regional Municipality of York — Town of Markham

1. That part of the King’s Highway known as No. 48 in the Town of Markham in The Regional Municipality of York lying between a point situate 70 metres measured southerly from its intersection with the centre line of the roadway known as Major Mackenzie Drive and a point situate 205 metres measured northerly from its intersection with the centre line of the roadway known as Major Mackenzie Drive.
