**1. The heading to Part II of Ontario Regulation 268/01 is revoked and the following substituted:****PART II****ONTARIO STUDENT LOANS MADE AFTER JULY 31, 2001****2. (1) Subsection 2 (1) of the Regulation is amended by adding the following definition:**

“master student loan agreement” means an agreement entered into under section 20;

**(2) The definition of “student loan agreement” in subsection 2 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

“student loan agreement” means an agreement entered into under section 20 as that section read on January 31, 2012.

**3. (1) Subsection 3 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:****Obtaining and repaying a student loan**

(1) An individual who wishes to obtain a student loan that is to be issued for a period of study commencing on or after August 1, 2012 must obtain a certificate of loan approval from the Minister in accordance with sections 4 to 17 and meet the requirements of sections 19 and 20.

**(2) Subsection 3 (2) of the Regulation is amended by striking out “student loan agreement” and substituting “master student loan agreement”.****(3) Section 3 of the Regulation is amended by adding the following subsection:**

(2.1) Subsections (1), (2) and (5), as they read on January 31, 2012, continue to apply to student loans that are issued for a period of study commencing before August 1, 2012.

**(4) Subsection 3 (5) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

(5) The repayment of the student loan is governed by sections 30 to 40.8 and by the terms of the master student loan agreement and the consolidated loan agreement.

**4. Sections 19 and 20 of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:****Obtaining a student loan**

**19.** A lender or a service provider on behalf of the lender shall issue a student loan to an individual in the amount set out in the certificate of loan approval for a period of study commencing on or after August 1, 2012 if,

- (a) the individual has received a certificate of loan approval and has entered into a master student loan agreement under section 20; and
- (b) the individual’s enrolment in the approved program of study has been confirmed by the approved institution.

**Master student loan agreement**

**20.** (1) A lender may enter into a master student loan agreement in accordance with this section where an individual applies for a student loan that is to be issued for a period of study commencing on or after August 1, 2012 and the lender is satisfied that the individual who applies for the student loan is entitled to one and has a certificate of approval.

(2) Where a master student loan agreement has been entered into under subsection (1), the master student loan agreement applies to all student loans received under the Act on or after the date on which the master student loan agreement was entered into.

(3) Subject to subsection (4), the parties to a master student loan agreement are the individual who wishes to obtain a student loan and the lender.

(4) Where the Minister is not the lender, Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister, is also a party to the master student loan agreement.

(5) Subject to subsection (6), the lender may amend the terms of the master student loan agreement.

(6) Amendments to the terms of the master student loan agreement are subject to both of the following rules:

1. For the amendments to be valid, the lender must give notice by posting the amended terms on the website for the Ministry.
2. The amendments shall only apply to student loans issued for a period of study commencing on or after the August 1 that is immediately after the posting referred to in paragraph 1.

(7) Despite subsection (2), an individual shall enter into a new master student loan agreement if two or more years have elapsed since the individual ceased to be a qualifying student under section 27.

(8) A master student loan agreement entered into under subsection (7) applies to all student loans received under the Act on or after the date on which the individual entered into the new master student loan agreement.

**5. Subsection 21 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**Restriction on advances**

(1) A lender or a service provider on behalf of a lender is not permitted to make an advance in respect of a student loan to an individual before the requirements in section 19 are met.

**6. The Regulation is amended by adding the following section:**

**Student loan agreements re period before August 1, 2012**

**21.1** Sections 19 and 20 and subsection 21 (1), as they read on January 31, 2012, continue to apply to student loans that are issued for a period of study commencing before August 1, 2012.

**7. Subsection 22 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**Duty to give notice of material change in circumstances**

(1) An individual who enters into a student loan agreement or enters into a master student loan agreement, under which the individual receives a student loan pursuant to section 19, is required to promptly notify the Minister or such person or entity as may be designated by the Minister for the purposes of this section of any material change in his or her circumstances that occurs during the period of study for which the loan is made.

**8. Section 22.1 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**Change of address**

**22.1** An individual who enters into a student loan agreement or enters into a master student loan agreement, under which the individual receives a student loan pursuant to section 19, shall promptly notify the service provider or such person or entity as may be designated by the Minister for the purposes of this section of any change of address that occurs after the person ceases to be a qualifying student under section 27 but before the repayment in full of the principal amount of the student loan and of any outstanding interest on that amount.

**9. Subsections 26 (1) and (2) of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:**

**Effect of status as qualifying student**

(1) While an individual is a qualifying student, his or her obligations to pay principal and interest under a student loan agreement, a master student loan agreement and a consolidated loan agreement, if any, are suspended.

(2) If the individual owes interest to the lender under the student loan agreement, master student loan agreement or consolidated loan agreement, if any, for a period during which he or she was not a qualifying student, and if the lender asks the individual to pay the accrued interest for that period, subsection (1) does not apply until the individual pays the accrued interest.

**10. Subsection 28 (1) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**Requirement for a consolidated loan agreement**

(1) Every individual shall enter into a consolidated loan agreement with the lender after the individual ceases to be a qualifying student if the individual has entered into,

- (a) one or more student loan agreements;
- (b) one or more master student loan agreements; or

(c) any combination of student loan agreements and master student loan agreements.

**11. Subsections 30 (1) and (2) of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:**

**Obligation to pay interest**

(1) An individual is not required to pay interest under a student loan agreement, a master student loan agreement or a consolidated loan agreement until the first day of the seventh month immediately following the month in which the individual ceased to be a qualifying student.

(2) The interest rate in effect on any day under a student loan agreement, a master student loan agreement or a consolidated loan agreement is the prime rate on that day plus 1 per cent.

**12. Section 44 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**Payments by lenders to the Minister**

**44.** If the Minister pays to a lender an amount in respect of a student loan, the lender shall remit to the Minister all amounts that may be collected or realized by the lender pursuant to the student loan agreement, master student loan agreement or consolidated loan agreement.

**1. The definition of “Ontario assets” in subsection 1 (2) of Regulation 909 of the Revised Regulations of Ontario, 1990 is amended by striking out “under clause 30 (2) (e)” at the end and substituting “under clause 30 (2) (e) or (e.1)”.**

**2. Subsection 30 (2) of the Regulation is amended by adding the following clause:**

(e.1) despite clause (e), if the pension plan is a designated multi-jurisdictional pension plan and if an agreement referred to in subsection 5.1 (1) of the Act provides for the allocation of the assets of the pension plan in accordance with paragraph 3 of subsection 100 (4) of the Act, allocating the assets in accordance with that agreement;

**3. Section 34 of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

**34.** (1) This section applies if the Guarantee Fund applies to a pension plan with a wind up date of December 8, 2010 or later.

(2) If, when the order is made declaring that the Guarantee Fund applies to the pension plan, the plan’s Ontario assets are less than its Ontario wind up liability,

(a) the administrator of the plan shall provide benefits under the plan in accordance with subsection (3); and

(b) on application by the administrator, the Superintendent shall allocate from the Guarantee Fund and pay to the plan sufficient money to provide, together with the Ontario assets, for those benefits.

(3) The administrator shall pay the greater of the following amounts to each person who is entitled on wind up to payment of benefits guaranteed by the Guarantee Fund or to payment of other amounts guaranteed by the Guarantee Fund:

1. The value of the person’s contributions to the plan plus interest.
2. The amount calculated using the formula,

$$A + B$$

in which,

“A” is 100 per cent of the benefits and other amounts for the person that are included in the calculation of the plan’s Guaranteed Benefit liability, and

“B” is the amount determined in accordance with subsection (4) that is related to all other benefits for the person that are included in the calculation of the plan’s Ontario wind up liability.

(4) The amount of the variable “B” for a person is determined as follows:

1. If the plan’s Ontario assets are less than or equal to its modified Ontario wind up liability, the amount of the variable “B” is calculated using the formula,

$$C \times D/E$$

in which,

“C” is the amount of the benefits in respect of the person that are included in the calculation of the plan’s modified Ontario wind up liability but are not included in the calculation of the plan’s Guaranteed Benefit liability,

“D” is the plan’s Ontario assets, and

“E” is the plan’s modified Ontario wind up liability.

2. If the plan's Ontario assets are greater than its modified Ontario wind up liability but are less than or equal to the sum of its modified Ontario wind up liability plus its liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements, the amount of the variable "B" is calculated using the formula,

$$C + F$$

in which,

"C" has the same meaning as in paragraph 1, and

"F" is the amount calculated using the formula,

$$G \times W/X$$

in which,

"G" is the amount of the benefits in respect of the person included in the calculation of the plan's liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements,

"W" is the amount by which the plan's Ontario assets exceed its modified Ontario wind up liability, and

"X" is the amount of the plan's liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements.

3. If the plan's Ontario assets are greater than its modified Ontario wind up liability plus its liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements, the amount of the variable "B" is calculated using the formula,

$$C + G + H$$

in which,

"C" has the same meaning as in paragraph 1,

"G" has the same meaning as in paragraph 2, and

"H" is the amount calculated using the formula,

$$J \times Y/Z$$

in which,

"J" is the amount, if any, of the benefits described in subsection 47 (2) for the person,

"Y" is the amount by which the plan's Ontario assets exceed the sum of its modified Ontario wind up liability and its liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements, and

"Z" is the amount of the plan's liability for the benefits described in subsection 47 (2).

(5) The Guaranteed Benefit liability of a pension plan is the total liability of the plan for benefits guaranteed by the Guarantee Fund and for other amounts guaranteed by the Guarantee Fund, excluding the amount by which the contributions made by any member, plus interest, for those guaranteed benefits and those other guaranteed amounts exceeds the liability for the member's guaranteed benefits and other guaranteed amounts.

- (6) The modified Ontario wind up liability of the pension plan is the amount calculated using the formula,

$$K - (L + M)$$

in which,

"K" is the plan's Ontario wind up liability,

"L" is the amount of the liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements, and

"M" is the amount of the liability, if any, for benefits described in subsection 47 (2).

(7) The liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements in respect of a pension plan is the liability for any increase to a pension or pension benefit or increase to the value of a pension or pension benefit that became effective within five years before the date of the wind up. However, it does not include any liability for benefits described in subsection 47 (2).

- (8) In this section,

"Guaranteed Benefit liability" means, for a pension plan, the liability described in subsection (5); ("passif rattaché aux prestations garanties")

"liability, if any, for recent benefit improvements" means, for a pension plan, the liability described in subsection (7); ("passif éventuel rattaché aux améliorations récentes des prestations")

- (b) on application by the administrator, the Superintendent shall allocate from the Guarantee Fund and pay to the plan sufficient money to provide, together with the Ontario assets, for those benefits.

**4. (1) Subsections 37 (4), (5) and (6) of the Regulation are revoked and the following substituted:**

(4) If the assessment date falls on or after January 1, 2012, the amount of the annual assessment is the greater of \$250 and the amount calculated using the formula,

$$A + B$$

in which,

“A” is the lesser of C and D, where,

“C” is the sum of \$5 for each person who was an Ontario plan beneficiary at the end of the plan fiscal year immediately preceding the assessment date plus the following amounts:

- 1. 0.5 per cent of any portion of the PBGF assessment base that is less than 10 per cent of the PBGF liabilities.
- 2. 1 per cent of any portion of the PBGF assessment base that is 10 per cent or more but less than 20 per cent of the PBGF liabilities.
- 3. 1.5 per cent of any portion of the PBGF assessment base that is 20 per cent or more of the PBGF liabilities, and

“D” is \$300 multiplied by the number of persons who were Ontario plan beneficiaries at the end of the plan fiscal year immediately preceding the assessment date, and

“B” is zero or, if an election under subsection 5 (18) is in effect on the assessment date, 2 per cent of the amount by which E exceeds F, where,

“E” is the amount of the additional liability that would result if, on the valuation date of the last report filed or submitted on or before the assessment date under any of section 3, 4 or 14 for the plan, all plant closure benefits and permanent layoff benefits under the plan were payable for those members in Ontario who, on that date, met the age and service requirements for those benefits, and

“F” is the amount, if any, by which the amount determined under clause (b) in the definition of “PBGF assessment base” in subsection 1 (2) exceeds the PBGF liabilities, both determined as of the valuation date referred to in the definition of “E”.

**(2) Subsection 37 (13) of the Regulation is revoked and the following substituted:**

(13) Despite subsection (4), the amount of the assessment is zero for a pension plan that was established fewer than five years before the assessment date, other than a pension plan that is a successor plan as described in subsection 80 (2) or section 81 of the Act.

**2.1** (1) Until the definition of “retired member” in subsection 1 (1) of the Act comes into force, a reference in this Regulation to a retired member of a pension plan is deemed to be a reference to a former member who has terminated employment or membership in the pension plan and in respect of whom one or more of the following criteria is satisfied:

1. He or she is receiving a pension payable from the pension fund.
2. He or she is entitled to begin to receive a pension from the pension fund by virtue of having reached the normal retirement date under the pension plan, even though he or she has not yet elected to receive the pension.
3. He or she has elected, under subsection 41 (1) of the Act, to receive an early retirement pension.
4. He or she has elected, under the terms of the pension plan, to begin payment of a pension payable from the pension fund, whether or not receipt of the first payment of the pension is deferred until a later date.

(2) Until the definition of “retired member” in subsection 1 (1) of the Act comes into force, a reference in this Regulation to a former member of a pension plan is deemed to be a reference to a former member who has terminated employment or membership in the pension plan and in respect of whom one or more of the following criteria is satisfied:

1. He or she is entitled to a deferred pension payable from the pension fund.
2. He or she is entitled to receive any other payment from the pension fund.

(3) However, if an individual is a former member as described in subsection (1), he or she is not a former member for the purposes of subsection (2).

(4) An individual who was a member of a pension plan and who has transferred an amount under subsection 42 (1) of the Act in connection with the pension plan is neither a former member as described in subsection (1) nor as described in subsection (2).

**(2) Section 2.1 of the Regulation is revoked.**

**Commencement**

**2. (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Regulation comes into force on January 1, 2012.**

**(2) Subsection 1 (2) comes into force on the day section 2 of the *Pension Benefits Amendment Act, 2010* (section 1.1 of the *Pension Benefits Act*) comes into force.**

2. Il a le droit de commencer à recevoir une pension de la caisse de retraite du fait qu'il a atteint la date normale de retraite prévue par le régime de retraite, même s'il n'a pas encore choisi de recevoir la pension.
3. Il a choisi, en vertu du paragraphe 41 (1) de la Loi, de toucher une pension de retraite anticipée.
4. Il a choisi, en vertu du régime de retraite, de faire commencer le paiement d'une pension sur la caisse de retraite, que la réception du premier paiement de la pension soit ou non différée jusqu'à une date ultérieure.

(2) Jusqu'à l'entrée en vigueur de la définition de «participant retraité» au paragraphe 1 (1) de la Loi, la mention d'un ancien participant dans le présent règlement vaut mention d'un ancien participant à un régime de retraite qui a mis fin à son emploi ou à son affiliation au régime et qui remplit un ou plusieurs des critères suivants :

1. Il a droit à une pension différée payable sur la caisse de retraite.
2. Il a le droit de recevoir une autre somme prélevée sur la caisse de retraite.

(3) Toutefois, le particulier qui est un ancien participant visé au paragraphe (1) n'est pas un ancien participant pour l'application du paragraphe (2).

(4) Le particulier qui était un participant et qui a transféré un montant en vertu du paragraphe 42 (1) de la Loi dans le cadre du régime de retraite n'est ni un ancien participant visé au paragraphe (1) ni un ancien participant visé au paragraphe (2).

**(2) L'article 2.1 du Règlement est abrogé.**

Entrée en vigueur

**2. (1) Sous réserve du paragraphe (2), le présent règlement entre en vigueur le 1<sup>er</sup> janvier 2012.**

**(2) Le paragraphe 1 (2) entre en vigueur le jour de l'entrée en vigueur de l'article 2 de la *Loi modifiant la Loi sur les régimes de retraite* (article 1.1 de la *Loi sur les régimes de retraite*).**
