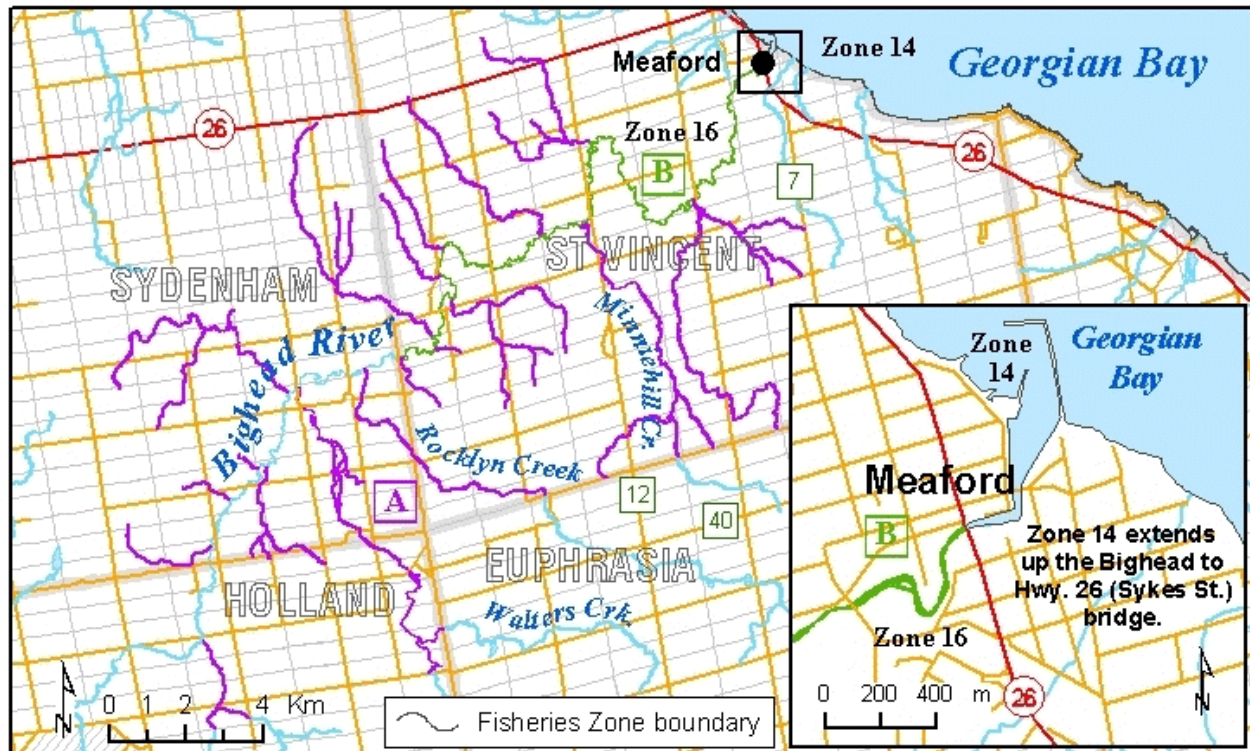


# Selected Fishing Regulations for Bighead River Meaford, Ontario, Fisheries Management Zones 14 & 16

## New Fisheries Management Zone boundaries

The boundaries of the old fishing divisions have been changed to create 20 new fisheries management zones across the province. New Zone 14 (Georgian Bay) now extends upstream into the Bighead River to the Hwy. 26 (Sykes St., in Meaford) bridge. **The season for Rainbow trout, Brown trout and Pacific Salmon is open all year within the waters of Zone 14.** Upstream of the point described above is now Zone 16.



### Zone 14 & 16 Seasons and Limits

#### Zone 14 Open Seasons

Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon  
Open all year



#### Zone 16 Open Seasons

Rainbow Trout Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon  
4<sup>th</sup> Sat. in April to September 30<sup>th</sup>.

#### Zones 14 & 16 Limits

Rainbow Trout – S-2, C-1  
Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon – S – 5, C -2

### Exceptions to the Zone Regulations

<b>A</b>		Bighead River tributaries within the Townships of Sydenham, St. Vincent, and Holland
<b>Fish sanctuary - no fishing from the 4th Saturday in April - May 31.</b>		
<b>B</b>		Bighead River within the Township of St. Vincent (Grey County)
<b>Rainbow trout, Brown trout and Pacific salmon extended fall season (4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in April to December 31<sup>st</sup>)</b>
