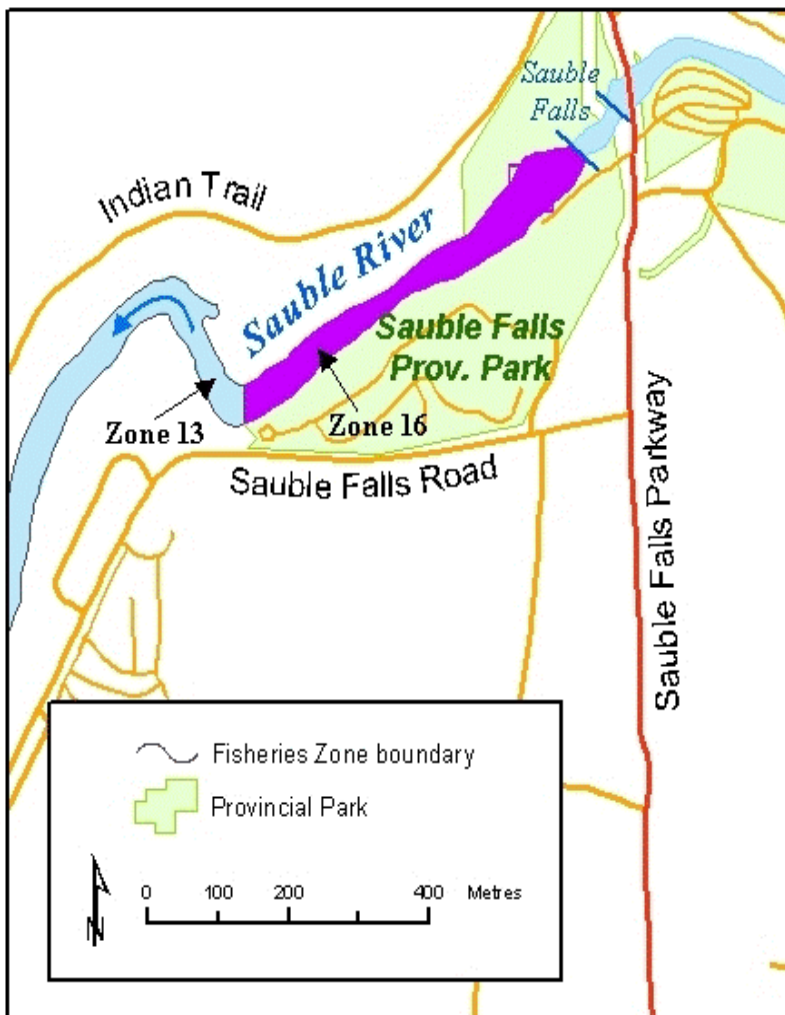


Selected Fishing Regulations for Sauble River, Sauble Falls, Ontario, Fisheries Management Zones 13 & 16

New Fisheries Management Zone boundaries

The boundaries of the old fishing divisions have been changed to create 20 new fisheries management zones across the province. New Zone 13 (Lake Huron) now extends upstream into the Sauble River to a point 440 m downstream from the lowest ledge of Sauble Falls. **The season for Rainbow trout, Brown trout and Pacific Salmon is open all year within the waters of Zone 13.** Upstream of the point described above is now Zone 16.



Zone 13 & 16 Seasons and Limits

Zone 13 Open Seasons

Rainbow Trout Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon – Open all year

Zone 16 Open Seasons

Rainbow Trout Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon – 4th Sat. in April to September 30th.

Zones 13 & 16 Limits

Rainbow Trout – S-2, C-1
Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon – S – 5, C -2

Additional Fishing Opportunities



Sauble River - Amabel Twp. from the lowest ledge of Sauble Falls 440 m downstream to a line drawn perpendicular to the rivers current.

Rainbow trout, Brown trout and Pacific Salmon extended fall season

4th Sat. in April to December 31st
(Zone 16 limits apply)
