Humber River and tributaries - upstream from Eglinton Ave. in the City of Toronto to the south side of the Hwy. 407 bridge in the Regional Municipality of York.

Little Otter Creek - East branch of Big Otter Creek in Bayham Twp.

Little Sauble River - Bruce Twp. from Hwy. 21 to Lake Huron (Bruce County).

Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout, Pacific Salmon and Atlantic Salmon extended fall season (4th Sat. in Apr. to Dec. 31) continued.

Highland Creek - City of Toronto from the downstream edge of the Hwy. 2 (Kingston Road) bridge to Lake Ontario.

Humber River - City of Toronto between Eglinton Ave. and Lake Ontario.

Nottawasaga River - from the Boyne River downstream (north) to Georgian Bay.

Rouge River - City of Toronto between Hwy. 2 and Lake Ontario.

any partners are working together to restore Atlantic Salmon to Lake Ontario. A state-of-the-art provincial hatchery – Normandale Fish Culture Station – is producing fish for release in restoration streams. Schools and outdoor education centres are raising Atlantic Salmon in the classroom, giving students a hands-on lesson in conservation. Over 180 stream habitat improvement projects have been completed.

New in 2016, anglers fishing Lake Ontario streams in Zones 16 and 17 now have an opportunity to fish for these Atlantic Salmon under new catch and release seasons. Anglers need to know how to identify Atlantic Salmon and must handle and immediately release fish with care.
