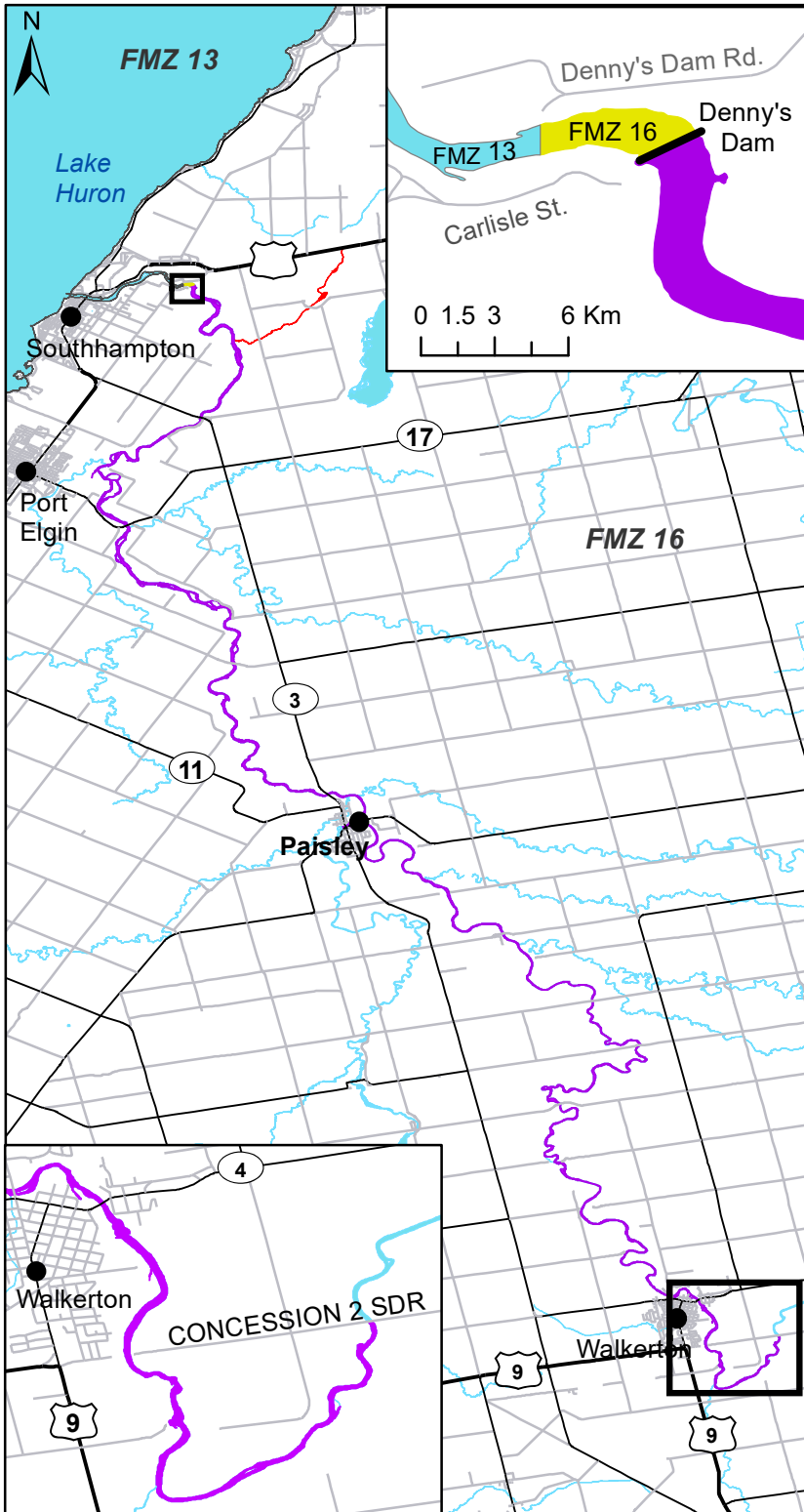


# Selected Fishing Regulations for Saugeen River, Southampton, Ontario, Fisheries Management Zone (FMZ) 13 and 16



## FMZ 13 and 16 Seasons

**FMZ 13, open seasons, selected species**  
Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout and Pacific Salmon  
**Open all year**

**FMZ 16, open seasons, selected species**  
Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout and Pacific Salmon  
**4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in April to September 30**

## Additional Fishing Opportunities



Saugeen River - Arran, Amabel, Brant, Carrick, Elderslie and Saugeen Townships and in the Town of Walkerton and the Village of Paisley, between the southerly edge of the Municipality of Brockton Concession 2 SDR bridge and the westerly edge of the concrete abutments downstream of Denny's Dam

- **Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon: Extended fall season from 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in April to December 31**



Saugeen River - Amabel and Saugeen Townships, Denny's Dam to the concrete abutments downstream

- **Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout and Pacific Salmon: Extended fall season from 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in April to December 31. Closed to night fishing October 1 to October 31 (from one half hour after sunset to one half hour before sunrise)**

## Exceptions to the Zone Regulations



The waters of that part of Sangs Creek and its tributaries lying within the Geographic Township of Arran in the County of Bruce.

- **Fish Sanctuary – no fishing from 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in April to May 31**
