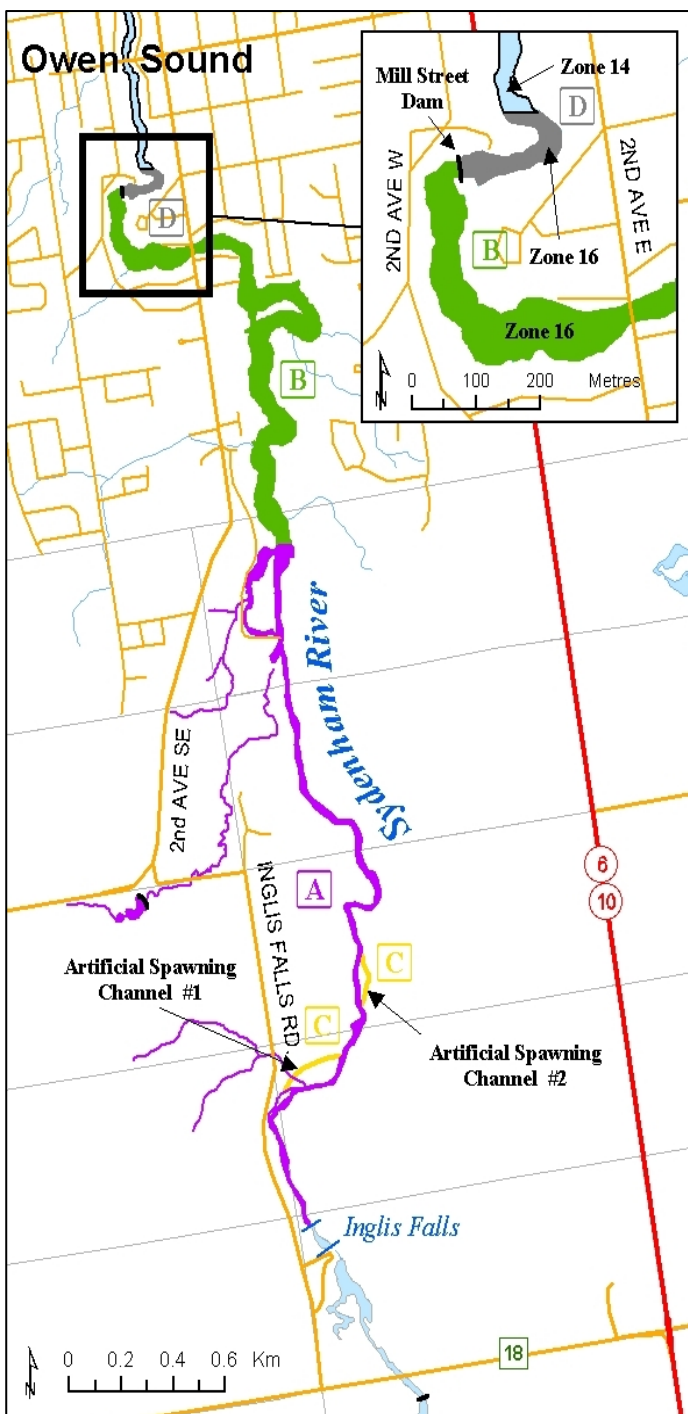


Selected Fishing Regulations for Sydenham River, Owen Sound, Ontario, Fisheries Management Zones 14 and 16



New Fisheries Management Zone Boundaries

New Zone 14 (Georgian Bay) now extends upstream into the Sydenham River to a point 177m (581 ft) below the Mill Street Dam (see map inset). **The season for Rainbow trout, Brown trout and Pacific salmon is open all year in the waters of Zone 14.** Upstream of this point is the new Zone 16. **The season for these species in Zone 16 is the 4th Sat. in April to September 30th.**

Exceptions to the Zone Regulations

A 

Sydenham River and tributaries in the City of Owen Sound and Derby Twp. from the base of Inglis Falls downstream to a line drawn due east from the north end of the bridge known locally as either Chinese or Rainbow Bridge to the permanent steel post marker affixed to the shore of the Sydenham River in Harrison Park.

Fish sanctuary - no fishing from the 4th Saturday in April to May 31st and from Sept. 1 - Sept. 30.

B 

Sydenham River in the City of Owen Sound and Derby Twp. From Inglis Falls to Mill Dam, excluding Artificial Spawning Channels Nos 1 and 2

Fish sanctuary - no fishing from the 4th Saturday in April to May 31.

C 

Sydenham River - Artificial Spawning Channels Nos. 1 and 2 - Derby Twp.

Fish sanctuary - closed all year.

D 

Sydenham River - City of Owen Sound, from the Mill Dam to a point 177 m (581 ft.) downstream.

Fish sanctuary - closed all year.
