Within the next two weeks, the Assistive Devices Program (ADP) will have moved to a new electronic channel for the submission of completed claims for all categories of devices. This channel allows ADP-registered vendors to submit their claims electronically, which improves the processing timeline and provides simpler, faster and better services for your clients who require funding towards eligible devices.

As a key stakeholder, your active participation is requested in order to ensure that the benefits of eSubmission are realized by your clients. The eSubmission process hinges around the use of the **updated ADP application form as posted to the Central Forms Repository**. By using this form and completing it electronically, you can ensure that the information submitted is appropriately formatted, including for example the legibility and the proper length of free form text. In addition, this will reduce errors and significantly reduce ADP's follow ups to you.
