

## **Executive Officer Notice:**

## ONTARIO DRUG BENEFIT PROGRAM – NEW ONLINE APPLICATIONS AND FORMS

Effective Date: October 10, 2023

To enrol Ontarians faster into the Trillium Drug Program (TDP) and Seniors Co-Payment Program (SCP), the ministry is modernizing the enrollment process through the launch of online forms ("eForms").

The eForms enable Ontarians to complete and submit their applications and supporting documents online, which will significantly reduce the need for follow-ups to obtain additional information and will reduce the time to enrolment.

For the initial launch, the ministry will be implementing nine eForms (in English and French). They will be hosted on a new Ontario Drug Benefit Program Online Application and Forms website at: <a href="https://forms.ontariodrugbenefit.ca">https://forms.ontariodrugbenefit.ca</a>.

Pharmacies and stakeholders should encourage potential applicants to the TDP and SCP to submit their applications, supporting documentation and prescription receipts online at: <a href="https://forms.ontariodrugbenefit.ca">https://forms.ontariodrugbenefit.ca</a>. The eForms provide guided instructions, ensure all necessary information required for enrolment is collected, and allow electronic submission. If computer access is not available, applicants can request that a paper copy of the TDP and SCP application and/or guide be mailed to them (see the contact information below).

Further to the eForms launch, the ministry has also updated the "Guide to Understanding the Trillium Drug Program" and created a new "Guide to Understanding the Seniors Co-Payment Program" to incorporate the latest policy and program changes and to assist Ontarians in navigating the Trillium Drug Program and Seniors Co-Payment Program.
