COVID-19 vaccines are available to everybody in Ontario over 6 months of age at no cost, regardless of citizenship or immigration status, **even if you do not have an**Ontario Health Card.



To find out how to book an appointment or if you have questions about the COVID-19 vaccine, please call the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre to speak to an agent or health specialist. Service is available in more than 300 languages from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. 7 days a week (excluding holidays).
