How to Track Requests and Access Ministry Response Letters in SADIE

Prescribers, their delegates and designates (with specific practice locations) receive real time access to the Ministry decisions and response letters in SADIE. They can also see historical correspondence (requests, additional information, response letters, etc.).

SADIE users receive system generated email notifications when a Ministry response is available. Notifications are sent to GO Secure email addresses.
