Re: Changes to Regulations under the Collection and Debt Settlement Services Act

I am writing to inform you of recent changes to the regulations under the Collection and Debt Settlement Services Act (CDSSA) that take effect on July 1, 2018.

These changes relate to requirements for certain registrants with respect to call recording, and contain new rules for legal professionals and enhancements to the administrative monetary penalties (AMPs) regime (including AMPs for contraventions of the new call recording provisions). These changes are further to amendments to the CDSSA and its General Regulation that were announced in 2017 as part of the "Consultation on Collection and Debt Settlement Services Act regulation reform", which can be found on Ontario's Regulatory Registry at http://www.ontariocanada.com/registry/.

In addition, and also as of July 1, 2018, collection agencies must provide additional information in their private written notices to debtors in the form of a new disclosure statement.
