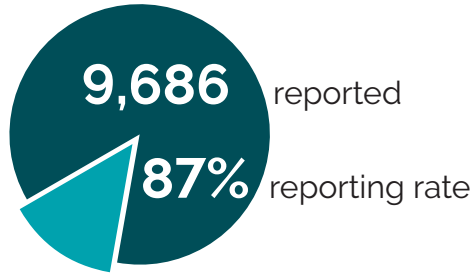




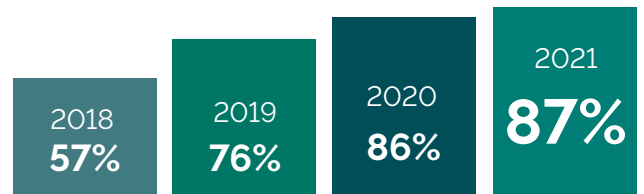
2021 Mandatory Wolf/Coyote Hunter Report Summary

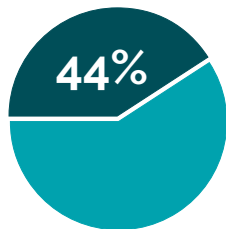

Reporting rates

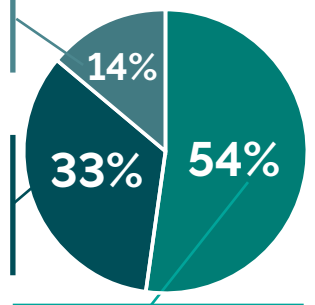


4,865 tag holders hunted

hunted wolves/coyotes in conjunction with deer, moose or bear hunting

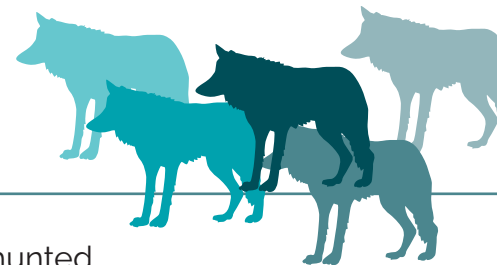
