

## 11. Eligible Expenses

The following expenses may be eligible if they are specifically required for biosecurity improvements and/or HPAI prevention and preparedness activities for the non-supply managed poultry sector:

- In-kind contributions, including contributions of existing full or part-time staff's labour and own equipment, cumulatively up to \$2,000 in cost-share per location (up to \$2,857.14 in eligible in-kind expenses)
- One-time labour costs (not in-kind), meaning contract salaries, benefits and specific per diem fees for persons that are not full or part-time staff of the applicant and that are persons at Arm's Length to the applicant
- One-time costs for the rental of facilities, processing equipment, or machinery with the exception of Education, Training, Assessment and Planning activities.

For additional eligible expenses that depend on the type of activity conducted by the applicant refer to the Initiative guidelines.

Following submission of the application form and assignment of a file number by Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) staff, the approved applicant will be provided with a link to the Claims Portal where expense claims can be submitted.

- Eligible expenses must be Incurred between 12:01 a.m. (EST) April 1, 2022 and 11:59 p.m. (EST) February 17, 2023.
- The deadline to submit expense claims with all supporting documentation via the Claims Portal is 11:59 p.m. (EST) February 28, 2023.

#### Note that:

- Eligible and complete expense claims submitted prior to the deadline will be reviewed on a first-come, first-serve basis, and reimbursed up to the Initiative funding maximums, as long as funding is available.
  - o Claims that are incomplete will not be processed until all necessary documentation and/or information is provided to OMAFRA.
  - o Submission of an incomplete claim (e.g., missing invoices) will not hold funds in queue.
- OMAFRA may request any additional information from the applicant that it considers necessary and reserves the right to inspect and verify costs and/or equipment associated with a claim (e.g., copies of any permits obtained by the applicant in incurring the expenses, photos).
- A business claiming Incurred expenses for multiple locations that are associated with the same CRA Business Number and were identified on the application form must submit a separate claim for each location.

I, the applicant, understand that (please check all boxes to indicate understanding and agreement):

Cost-share funding is calculated as 70 per cent of the verified eligible expenses incurred and paid as per Initiative guidelines, up to a maximum amount of \$100,000 per location. No single business is eligible to receive more than \$500,000.

Applicants approved under the Initiative and subsequently provided with access to the Claims Portal are not guaranteed funding under this Initiative. Funding to eligible applicants will be considered on a first-come, first-serve basis.

#### SECTION C: CERTIFICATION, NOTICE, AND CONSENT

If approved, funding is conditional upon the applicant's acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Poultry Biosecurity Preparedness Initiative ("Initiative") under the Canadian Agricultural Partnership (the Partnership).

The applicant may also be referred to as "you" (or "your") below.

You must certify on this application that:

- You have read, understand, and agree to abide by all requirements of the Initiative.
- All sources and pending sources of funding, including funds from federal, provincial and municipal governments, cumulatively, will not, exceed 100 per cent of costs.

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- The applicant does not currently owe any money to Ontario, or you have attached a detailed description of the applicant's debt to Ontario to this application.
- You are not, nor is any officer, director or employee of the applicant (if any) a current
  or former federal public office holder or federal public servant, or, if you, or any
  officer, direct or employee of the applicant (if any) are a current or former federal
  public officer holder or federal public servant, you or that officer, director or
  employee of the applicant (if any) are in compliance with the *Conflict of Interest Act*,
  the Conflict of Interest Code for Members of the House of Commons, the Values and
  Ethics Code for the Public Sector and the Policy on Conflict of Interest and Postemployment, as applicable.
- You are not, nor is any officer, director or employee of the applicant (if any), a member of the House of Commons or of the Senate, or if you, or any officer, director or employee of the applicant (if any) are, you or the officer, director or employee of the applicant (if any) are permitted under the *Parliament of Canada Act* to receive funding from Canada under the Partnership.
- The applicant shall retain all records relating to any payments made to the applicant under this Initiative, including all invoices and proof of payment for at least seven (7) years from the date on which the expense claim is paid.

## You accept that:

- The Initiative is a discretionary, non-entitlement initiative and the applicant is not entitled to funding merely as a consequence of submitting an application.
   Applications will be assessed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Furthermore, payments, if any, are subject to approval by way of application, letter from OMAFRA; Ontario receiving all the necessary appropriations from the Ontario Legislature; Ontario receiving all the necessary monies from Canada; the applicant and the applicant's incurred, paid and submitted expenses satisfying all of the eligibility criteria; as well as the applicant's compliance with all terms and conditions of the Initiative and the Minister's Order 0005/2018, as may be amended from time to time.
- Any funding received will related exclusively to expenses for enhanced biosecurity preparedness and response against Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in Ontario.
- If it is determined the applicant has received a payment the applicant was not eligible
  to receive, through administrative error or otherwise or by reason of noncompliance with the terms and conditions of the Initiative and the Minister's Order
  0005/2018, as may be amended from time to time), the applicant will repay any and
  all payments as well as any surplus funding plus accrued interest upon it forthwith
  upon demand.
- Any payments made or payable to the applicant may be subject to recovery or set-off against the applicant's pre-existing debts to the Crown in Right of Ontario or Canada.
- Terms not defined within this application form shall have the definitions assigned to them in the Guidelines and Minister's Order 0005/2018, as may be amended from time to time.

- Ontario, Ontario's program administrator (if any) or Canada, including their respective Ministers, directors, officers, agents, employees or representatives (as applicable), shall not be liable for any damage or loss whatsoever, or howsoever arising, including damage or loss arising from any advice, opinions, representations, warranties or the provision of information under the Initiative.
