Provincial Possession Limits (page 13) Yellow Perch – 100

Fisheries Management Zone 15 (page 108-110)

The close time for Lake Trout is **September 30** for the following waterbodies: Drizzle, Hay, Otter Creek (x2 locations), Tallan, Buzzard, Chandos, Deer, Eels, Holland, Hudson, Jamieson, Jeffrey, Lavallee, Stoplog, and Wahwashkesh

Fisheries Management Zone 15 (page 111)

The open time for Muskellunge on Pickerel River is the **first** Saturday in June

Fisheries Management Zone 16 (page 124)

Bighead River **tributaries** – fish sanctuary fourth Saturday in April to May 31

Fisheries Management Zone 17 (page 129)

The fish sanctuary is from January 1 to the Friday **after** the second Saturday in May and November 16 to December 31 for the following locations within waterbodies: Burleigh Falls, Perry's Creek and Stony Lake, Fishog River, Gull River, Healey Falls, Katchewanooka Lake, Lovesick Dams, Lower Buckhorn Lake (Buckhorn Lake), Otonabee River (x4 locations), Pigeon River, Scugog River, Talbot River, and Trent River

Fisheries Management Zone 19 (page 135)

Atlantic Salmon – **open all year**; possession limits are S-1 and C-0

Fisheries Management Zone 20 (page 139)

St. Lawrence River – two lines **may not be used** from a boat in open water
